Subject: Monthly Report - January 2025

In January 2025, the Key West Police Department's Communication Center received 5,401 calls into the dispatch center. Of those calls, 1,680 came directly to 911. Those calls generated 2,296 calls for service for police/fire/rescue. Compared to January 2024, we experienced an 1% decrease in 911 calls, a 0.9% increase in non-emergency calls, and an 0.7% decrease in calls for service for police/fire/rescue.

Officers completed 583 police reports and 142 arrests were made. Compared to January 2024, police reports increased by 3.9% and arrests increased by 47.9%.

A total of 780 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 218 citations and 141 written warnings.
