A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) AND 2-797(4)b. OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) CUSTOM REVOLVE AIR SYSTEMS 6000 psi AIR TRAILER WITH REVOLVE AIR FILL STATION AND SMART FILL ATTACHED STORAGE, INCLUDING ALL REQUIRED OPTIONS AND EQUIPMENT, FROM MES LIFE SAFETY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$225,955.00 UTILIZING LAKE COUNTY CONTRACT #22-730G; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY RELATED DOCUMENTS AND BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Custom Revolve Air Systems Trailer provides on-scene, NFPA 1901-compliant mobile filling of SCBA cylinders, ensuring reliable access to clean breathing air during fires, hazardous materials incidents and prolonged emergency operations across our island community; and

WHEREAS, the current 2008 Scott air trailer utilized by the Key West Fire Department (KWFD) has exceeded its frontline service life and experiences frequent out-of-service downtime, creating unacceptable risk and operational gaps jeopardizing firefighter life safety and eliminating a vital resource mission-critical to KWFD operations; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2-797(3)c., KWFD is seeking Commission approval to purchase one (1) Custom Revolve Air Systems 6000 psi Air Trailer with Revolve Air Fill Station and

Smart Fill attached storage, including all required options and equipment, from MES Life Safety in the amount of \$225,955.00 by utilizing Lake County Contract #22-730G, pursuant to Section 2-797(3)b. of the City's Code of Ordinances which authorizes purchases and acquisitions under contracts of the federal government and the state or its political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, this purchase will be paid from funds budgeted and available in FY 2025/26 Fire Department Infrastructure Surtax Fund 101-2201-522-6400 and requires no additional appropriation; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2-797(3)b., staff's price analysis confirms the quoted amount is fair and competitive under the awarded contract, with an estimated delivery of approximately three (3) months from the date of order; and

WHEREAS, any delay in replacement of the current unreliable 2008 Scott air trailer will likely increase costs due to ongoing supply chain constraints and escalating material prices. Procuring this critical equipment now will secure guaranteed pricing and near-term delivery; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-797(4)b. of the City's Code of Ordinances, the City Manager has determined this purchase to be in the best interest of the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Pursuant to Section 2-797(3) and Section 2-797(4)b. of the City's Code of Ordinances, and in the best interests of the City, the City Commission hereby authorizes the purchase of one (1) Custom Revolve 6000 psi Air Trailer with Revolve Air Fill Station and Smart Fill attached storage, including all required options and equipment, from MES Life Safety in the amount of \$225,955.00, utilizing Lake County Contract #22-730G.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby finds that adequate funds for this purchase are budgeted and available in FY 25-26 Fire Department Infrastructure Surtax Fund 101-2201-522-6400.

Section 3: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any necessary related documents and budget transfers/adjustment, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
