A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF THE ATTACHED "REVOCABLE LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR USE OF CITY PROPERTY" BETWEEN THE CITY AND STEAMPLANT CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.; DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO INVESTIGATE AND MOVE FORWARD ON ANY REQUIREMENTS TO USE THAT PUBLIC PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXERCISING ANIMALS (DOG PARK); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 11-234, the City Commission approved a Revocable License Agreement with the Steamplant Condominium Association, Inc. for landscaping and maintenance of a city-owned vacant parcel on Trumbo Road; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it would be in the best interests of the City to terminate the Revocable License Agreement, in order to provide public space for the purpose of exercising animals (a "dog park");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is directed to provide the Steamplant Condominium Association, Inc. with a Notice of Termination for the "Revocable License Agreement For Use of City Property."

Section 2: That City staff is directed to investigate and move forward on determining necessary requirements, if any, to use that public property for the purpose of exercising animals ("dog park").

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
