Introduction

The City Manager's Office requests the approval of the "Mile Zero Fights 10" for an Amateur Fighting event at the Truman Waterfront Quay Wall on Saturday, September 16, 2023, from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Background

The City Manager's Office has received an application from the "MZF Mile Zero Fights, LLC." for an event at the Truman Waterfront Quay Wall on Saturday, September 16, 2023, from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. This is a fighting event that consist of boxing, kickboxing, and MMA. The event is a fundraiser for the Key West Police Benevolent League which is an organization that helps local kids participate in recreational activities. The event historically has approximately five hundred visitors in attendance. The applicant has agreed to abide by City Codes and Ordinances, including providing insurance.

Procurement

There will be no additional expenses to the city as all service costs (Police/Fire/Community Services) are covered by the applicant, based on the Special Event Matrix.
