-- Iain Graham Marshall Arrest Narrative:

On 04/22/2023, at approximately 0042 hours, Ofc. Torrecillas and I, Ofc. Gruba, were flagged down by security at The Red Garter Saloon, 208 Duval St, in reference to a male who was in the club and had stolen a velvet rope the previous night from the club.

Security showed me video of the individual taking the rope right outside the doors to the club. The individual then proceeds to hold the rope above his head, as if he were victorious in a battle, and ran off with the rope. Security pointed out the individual sitting in the club. I walked over and asked the guy to speak outside. The man, later identified as Iain Marshall, complied and we walked out a side door to Charles St. Security showed Marshall the video and Marshall said that the man in the video was not him. I took a second look at the video and saw that the faces and build were the same, also the man in the video was wearing the same exact sandals and hat that Marshall was wearing. Marshall continued to deny that the man in the video was him. Marshall was told by Red Garter Security that they needed the velvet rope back or the estimated \$100 to replace the stolen rope. Marshall said that he would not pay the money, but he might know where the rope was. Marshall eventually said that the rope was at the place that he was staying at. Several times during my conversation with Marshall, he asked me if he was being detained. I told Marshall several times that he was. Marshall acknowledged that he was being detained. While I was trying to obtain footage of the theft, Marshall tried to divert our attention, by saying that the rope was next to our patrol cars down the street. Marshall then ran West on Charles St and turned South onto Telegraph Ln. I caught up to Marshall at a dirt parking lot, on Telegraph, behind Teasers. I redirected Marshall to the ground by wrapping him up. Once on the ground, I placed Marshall into handcuffs. I escorted Marshall back to my patrol vehicle. On the way back to my patrol vehicle Marshall asked if it was too late to get the rope, because he knew where it was. Sgt. Revoredo took pictures of the minor cuts that were sustained during the response to resistance. It is to be noted that during the response to resistance my cell phone was severely damaged to the point that it was inoperable, my prescription glasses were broken, and my pants were ripped.

Marshall was transported to Monroe County Detention Center.

Iain Graham Marshall violated Florida State Statute 812.014-2E, PETIT THEFT \$100 TO \$750. Marshall knowingly and unlawfully obtained the Velvet rope (property alleged) of Red Garter Saloon (victim). Marshall did so with intent to, either temporarily or permanently, deprive Red Garter Saloon of the right to the property or any benefit from it.

Iain Graham Marshall violated Florida State Statute 843.02, Resist Officer Without Violence. Marshal resisted my lawful execution of a legal duty. At the time I was an Officer and Marshall knew I was an Officer, due to my class "B" KYPD uniform and my patrol vehicle. As stated in the narrative, Marshall understood that he was being detained for an investigation of theft.

My BWC was activated during this incident.
