### -- Christopher Clare Stinnett Arrest Narrative:

On 03/18/2025 at approximately 0001 hours, I (Ofc. Vanderhoof) was performing foot patrol at the intersection of Duval St and Charles St when I was flagged down by the security at Red Garter Saloon (208 Duval St).

As I was walking over I witnessed a male subject who was yelling at the security of the establishment. The male was later identified as Christopher Stinnett (Arrestee).

Stinnett was being removed from Red Garter and the staff of Red Garter wanted him trespassed for spitting in one of the security personnel's faces.

As I asked Stinnett for his ID so I can continue with my trespassing investigation he turned away and began leaving the scene by running from us. I chased Stinnett and eventually caught up to him in front of Ricks Bar (202 Duval St). Stinnett was already stumbling and falling towards the ground as I was able to catch him. I went to the ground with Stinnett and attempted to gain control of him. While on the ground with Stinnett he resisted all commands and directions to stop resisting and to put his hands behind his back. Due to Stinnett's level of resistance, I delivered three closed fist strikes to the right side of his midsection, in the rib cage area. Stinnett continued to resist and refuse to put his hands behind his back. Ofc. Flores drive stunned Stinnett multiple times in his back. We were eventually able to gain control of Stinnett and handcuff him behind the back. See Ofc. Christina's and Ofc. Flores's supplemental reports for further information on their involvement.

It should be noted that Stinnett's actions caused a large scene and crowd of people to form.

I escorted Stinnett to Ofc. Flores's patrol vehicle where he was transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center for medical clearance. Stinnett was then transported to the Monroe County Detention Center where he was turned over to the detention center staff.

The security from Red Garter, identified as Nathan Rogers (Victim), wished to pursue charges against Stinnett for spitting in his face. Rogers was given a victim's rights brochure.

Ofc. Christina sustained a large scratch on his face during our scuffle with Stinnett. I was able to take a picture of the injury, and it was uploaded to Evidence.com.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 03/18/2025, Christopher Stinnett did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.01 Resisting with Violence, by scratching Ofc. Christina in the face while refusing to put his hands behind his back while we were engaged in our legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officers.

Based on the facts and the evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 03/18/2025 Christopher Stinnett did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.02, by actually and purposefully attempting to run away from me as I was conducting a trespassing investigation and for refusing to identify himself as I was engaged in my legal, lawful duties as a uniformed law enforcement officer.

Based on the facts and the evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 03/18/2025 Christopher Stinnett did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 784.03 Battery, by actually and purposefully spitting in Nate Rogers face

as Rogers was working as security at the Red Garter Saloon.

Based on the facts and evidence I have probable cause to believe that on 03/18/2025, Christopher Stinnett actually and intentionally violated Florida State Statute 877.03- Disorderly Conduct by purposefully committing acts that were of a nature that corrupted the public morals and outraged the sense of public decency, while also affecting the peace and quiet of persons who witnessed the act or acts by causing such a commotion that people had to stop what they were doing to avoid the interaction and causing a large group of individuals to form a crowd.

My BWC was active for the encounter. I uploaded my BWC to Evidence.com.

At this time, no further information.

On 03-18-2025, I K-9 Ofc. Matthew Hansell of the Key West Police Department, was working off duty spring break crowd control on lower Duval St.

I had just walked back from the East side of Duval St. and saw Ofc. Christina, Ofc. Roberts, Ofc. Flores and Ofc. Vanderhoof, speaking with a male who had been asked to leave The Red Garder.

The male was being trespassed by staff for causing an unknown problem. Ofc. Christian was speaking with the male before the male turned and walked away. It was at this time that Ofc. Vanderhoof re-engaged with the subject to let him know he was being trespassed.

I observed the male turn away from officers and run toward Green St., however due to the crowd he ended up falling in front of Dirty Harry's. I made my way over as Ofc. Christian and Ofc. Vanderhoof attempted to detain Stinnett. Stinnett was actively resisting arrest and had pulled his arms under neath him in an attempt to avoid being hand cuffed.

I grabbed Stinnett's left wrist while telling him to, ' Stop resisting.'` and brought it back behind his back only for him to twist his body to the right side and pull his arm back under his chest. After several more attempts to pull his arm out I was able to get it back behind his back, only after Ofc. Flores provided two drive stuns in order to gain compliance.

Stinnett was brought over to Charles St. and placed into Ofc. Flores patrol vehicle.

My Axon BWC was sued for this case.

On 03/18/2025 at approximately 0001 hours I (Ofc. Flores) was conducting a foot patrol on Charles Street and Duval Street when a bouncer at 208 Duval Street (Red Garter Saloon) flagged myself and other officers down. The bouncer explained that the male was being kicked out and wanted him off the property.

Upon making contact with the male, I saw him speaking with Ofc. Christina and Ofc. Vanderhoof. The male then turned and began to run north on Duval Street towards Greene Street. I ran after the male before seeing he had fallen onto his stomach, in front of 202 Duval Street (Rick's Bar). I could see that Ofc. Christina was at the male's head and Ofc. Vanderhoof on the male's back. I went to the male's right side and saw that he had his arms tucked in, under his chest. I began to issue verbal commands to the male, telling him to "Give him your arm" with no change in behavior from the male. I then yelled "Move, taser" before pulling out my department issued AXON Taser 7 and giving the verbal command of "Give him your arm or you're going to get drive-stunned now." The male then turned onto his back, yelling about his shoulder before he was turned on his side. I then utilized the drive-stun technique in the middle of the male's back, before issuing the verbal command of "Roll over. You're going to get drive-stunned again, roll over." The male was then turned onto his side and still resisting, not rolling onto his stomach. Due to the male not following my verbal commands to roll onto his stomach, I utilized the drive-stun technique again in the middle of the male's back. The male then rolled onto his stomach, continuing to struggle and resist. I kept a hand on the male's back to prevent him from rolling back towards me while my taser was still in my hand, to the side away from his body.

I then stood up, grabbing my property before assisting in transporting the male to a patrol vehicle on Charles Street and Duval Street. I searched the male at the front of the patrol vehicle, placing his property on the hood of the patrol vehicle. After searching the male, he was transported to my patrol vehicle and placed in the backseat on the passenger side. The in-car camera was turned on inside my patrol vehicle while the male was in the back.

Sargent M. Del Valle responded to the scene per Key West Police Department policy.

Once the male was secure in the back of my patrol vehicle, Ofc. M. Hansell gave me the male's property to hold onto. I went to the back of my patrol vehicle, placing the male's property into a paper bag and placed the bag in my front seat. The male was identified as Christopher C. Stinnett (DOB: 11/14/1973, Arrestee) with his Florida driver's license.

I transported Stinnett to Lower Keys Medical Center to get medical clearance in my patrol vehicle. Once Stinnett was given medical clearance and discharge paperwork, he was transported to Monroe County Detention Center without further incident.

My Axon BWC was active for this incident. My Axon Fleet was active for transportation to Lower Keys Medical

Narrative

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

On March 18, 2025, officers were dispatched to 208 Duval Street regarding a battery incident involving a security staff member. Upon arrival, Officer Christina initiated contact with Stinnett, the suspect. During the interaction, Stinnett abruptly turned and walked away from Officer Christina.

Officer Vanderhoof attempted to re-engage with Stinnett to continue the investigation. When asked to produce identification, Stinnett refused to provide it and immediately fled on foot. While running through a densely crowded area, Stinnett tripped and fell to the ground.

As officers attempted to take him into custody, Stinnett actively resisted arrest by pulling his arms under his body. He tensed his body and tried to prevent being handcuffed. Despite multiple loud verbal commands from Officer Vanderhoof instructing him to place his arms behind his back, Stinnett refused to comply as he continued to make evasive movements to defeat the officer's actions as they tried to handcuff him.

Officer Vanderhoof and Officer Christina delivered fist strikes to Stinnett. Officer Christina first delivered one fist strike to Stinnet's left shoulder to gain compliance. Stinnett did not comply and continued to resist. Officer Vanderhoof then delivered three fist strikes to Stinnett's right midsection to gain compliance. Stinnett continued to resist, prompting Officer Flores to deploy her Taser 7 in drive stun mode. After receiving two pain compliance cycles to his upper back area, Stinnett complied, and he was handcuffed.

Officers Christina and M. Hansell assisted in handcuffing Stinnett. During the arrest, Stinnett scratched Officer Christina's forehead.

I spoke with Stinnett, Stinnett said he ran from Officers and he was compliant. I asked him if he was injured and he told me that his only complaint of injury was shoulder pain. He advised that this was related to a pre-existing condition for which he had undergone surgery approximately four years ago and had an MRI done I photographed Stinnett, and he was subsequently transported to Lower Keys Medical Center, where he was medically cleared.
