**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "TASK ORDER" IN THE AMOUNT OF \$180,122.00 BETWEEN JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA FOR ENGINEERING, DESIGN, AND PERMITTING SERVICES FOR THE ATLANTIC BOULEVARD PAVING REHABILITATION PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of Key West owns and maintains Atlantic Boulevard, a roadway subject to tidal influence, recurring localized flooding, and pavement deterioration requiring engineering evaluation and rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to proceed with engineering, design, environmental permitting, and preparation of construction documents to improve roadway resilience, upgrade drainage performance, and enhance long-term functionality of Atlantic Boulevard while minimizing impacts to adjacent private property and environmental resources;

WHEREAS, Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc., under the City's General Engineering Services Agreement City Commissioned Approved Resolution No 23-039 with two-year extension under Resolution No. 26-045, has submitted a proposed Task Order to perform preliminary

engineering, design plans (60%, 95%, 100%), environmental permitting (USACE and SFWMD), technical memoranda, drainage documentation, and an Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Task Order provides a total estimated compensation of \$180,122.00, including \$161,823.00 for Task A design services, \$6,659.00 for bid-phase support, and cost-reimbursable expenses and allowances for travel and permitting fees; and

WHEREAS, the design and support services described in the Task Order are expected to require approximately 76 weeks, consisting of 24 weeks for design and 52 weeks for bid-phase and limited construction support services; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineering Department recommends approval of the Task Order to advance this critical infrastructure project and support roadway resilience and climate adaptation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Task Order in the amount of \$180,122.00 between the City of Key West and Jacobs Engineering Group,

Inc. for Engineering, Design, and Permitting Services for the Atlantic Boulevard Paving Rehabilitation Project is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funding for this Task Order is available in the appropriate Infrastructure fund Account No. 102-4102-541-6300.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney and any necessary budget transfers/adjustments.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
