A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING U.S. COAST SECTOR WEST TO HOLD THE GUARD KEY ANNUAL VETERANS DAY PARADE ON DUVAL STREET ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2025, FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M. (SETUP AT 2:00 P.M.); AUTHORIZING THE **CLOSURE** CERTAIN STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID PARADE FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M.; WAIVING FEES FOR REQUIRED CITY SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, U.S. Coast Guard Sector Key West wishes to conduct the annual "Veterans Day Parade" on Duval Street during the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. (setup at 2:00 p.m.) on Tuesday, November 11, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor

therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That U.S. Coast Guard Sector Key West is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That U.S. Coast Guard Sector Key West will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That pursuant to Section 6-26(c), for cause shown upon the record, a special exception to the requirement of payment for required city services set forth in Section 6-26(a) is hereby granted, waiving all fees for required city services for the Veterans Day Parade.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the Commission.
