On 03/06/2025, at 1133 hours, I (Ofc. R. Perez) was dispatched to the Key West Bight Dockmaster's Office in reference to a suspicious female. While in route I was advised that the female was smoking cigarettes near a gas pump and was asked to leave several times.

Upon arrival, I see a female later identified by her Florida DL as Melissa Godin, sitting on the dock near the gas pump with cigarettes and a large wine bottle sitting next to her. Godin was sitting next to a dinghy. I approached and asked Godin to show me her ID Godin said "no" and began to board the dinghy. I reached out and grabbed Godin's arm and told her to get off the dinghy. Godin pulled away from me and sat in the back corner of the dinghy's stern. I gave Godin several loud verbal commands to get off the dinghy and to identify herself. Godin refused to comply with my orders.

The Dockmasters' assistant, a female previously identified by her Florida DL as Olivia Nash, walked out of the office and spoke with me. Nash stated that she had told Godin that she could not smoke near the gas pumps and Godin refused to comply. She then told Godin to leave the area and she refused to leave. She then saw Godin put out her cigarette and tossed the butt of the cigarette into the water. She asked Godin to leave the area and she continued to refuse. I asked Nash who the dinghy belonged to and she stated that it did not belong to Godin. Godin had been trying to find a ride to Wisteria Island all day.

I then spoke to the Dockmaster, a male previously identified by his Florida DL as Stanley Loveday. Loveday stated that earlier in the day he saw Godin drinking wine near the dinghy docks. Loveday told her that she needed to leave Key West Bight and that she cannot drink on the dock. Loveday stated that she does not own a dinghy nor did she have a pass to park a dinghy at the dinghy docks.

Ofc. Medina and Ofc. Sharpe approached the area and I asked Loveday if he had a safe area for me to store my gun belt and vest. Loveday showed me an area to place my gear. I removed my vest and my gun belt to prepare to board the dinghy that Godin was sitting in. I removed the equipment to not ruin it in case I were to fall in the water and to not hinder my ability to swim. I walked toward the dinghy and Ofc. Sharpe was speaking to Godin and asking her to please exit the boat and Godin refused. Godin began to use SIRI on her phone and began to ask SIRI for legal advice.

Ofc. Sharpe held the bow line of the dinghy and I stepped down into the dinghy. I saw a stern line and tossed the stern line to Ofc. Medina. Ofc. Sharpe and Ofc. Medina tried to stabilize the dingy to avoid me falling into the water. I approached Godin and told her to stand up, Godin refused. I grabbed Godin's left arm and she tensed up and refused to stand up. I stood Godin up, walked her toward the bow, she pulled away causing the boat to rock and we both fell forward. I stood back up, tried to stand Godin up again and she went limp trying to be dead weight. I then carried Godin and placed her onto the dock. Ofc. Medina, Ofc. Sharpe and I placed Godin into handcuffs.

Ofc. Medina contacted Sgt. Siracuse and explained to him that we just had an RRI when we attempted to detain Godin. Due to the call volume and the severity of other incidents occurring at the same time Sgt. Siracuse was unable to respond to the scene. Godin did not sustain any visible injuries, but she had a small amount of broken skin on her left foot. I am unsure if that occurred when I attempted to detain her or prior to our interaction. I took pictures of the broken skin.

Before we took Godin to my patrol vehicle, we asked if there was any of her property in the boat, she stated that a

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yellow backpack and a laptop on the dock belonged to her. I walked Gooding toward my patrol vehicle and placed her into the back seat of my patrol vehicle. Ofc. Sharpe began to search the yellow backpack incident to arrest. While searching the yellow backpack Ofc. Sharpe found a clear glass pipe with burn marks and residue in the pipe. Based on my training and experience, the glass pipe that Ofc. Sharpe found in Godin's backpack is used to smoke either meth or crack.

Godin was transported to the Monroe County Detention center without incident.

Ofc. Sharpe stayed on scene and collected witness statement forms from Loveday and Nash. Ofc. Sharpe and Ofc. Medina also placed the pipe into the KWPD Property and Evidence Division as evidence.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that Melissa Godin did knowingly and intentionally, posses a pipe commonly used to smoke meth or cocaine, violating F.S.S. 893.147(1) possession of drug paraphernalia.

Furthermore, Melissa Godin refused to leave the fuel pumps at Key West Bight Marina after being told to leave by both Loveday and Nash violating F.S.S. 810.09(2)(a) trespassing property not structure or conveyance.

Lastly, Melissa Godin, did knowingly and willingly resist Ofc. Sharpe's, Ofc. Medina's and my lawful orders without violence, obstructing Ofc. Sharpe, Ofc. Medina and I from conducting our legal duties violating F.S.S. 843.02 resisting officer without violence.

My AXON BWC was activated during this incident. When I removed my vest to retrieve Godin from the Dinghy my BWC was still attached to my vest that was left in the Dockmaster's Office.

On Thursday, 03/06/2025, I, Officer Sharp, and Ofc. Medina (Field Training Officer) responded to 201 William Street (Dockmaster's Office) to assist Ofc. Perez with a suspicious person.

On arrival, Ofc. Perez told us the suspicious person, later identified as Melissa Godin (Arrestee, DOB: 08/30/1982), had been asked to leave twice by two different employees, was drinking alcohol and smoking by the fuel lines, and dumped her cigarette in the ocean thus littering. Ofc. Perez advised us that Godin was currently refusing to comply with Ofc. Perez's lawful commands. When I arrived, I observed Godin acting erratically, and possibly under the influence of alcohol or drugs due to her erratic mannerisms and speech. Godin was curled into a corner of a small dinghy boat that Stanley Loveday, Dockmaster, advised was not hers.

Dockmaster Stanley Loveday and Olivia Nash, who I later had complete witness statement forms, said they had individually asked Godin to leave due to her smoking by the fuel lines, littering her cigarette butts, and witnessing her drinking alcohol and acting erratically.

Encountering Godin, she acted as if she was talking to Siri on the phone. Godin continued to act unruly and refused to respond to lawful commands from myself, Ofc. Medina and Ofc. Perez to identify herself, due to her being trespassed from the Dockmaster's Office. Godin seemed to be having incoherent conversations with what alternated between us, her phone, and herself. She continued to refuse to identify herself for several minutes. Ofc. Perez warned her we would remove her from the boat and charge her with resisting, as she was obstructing a lawful investigation by refusing to identify herself. Godin continued to refuse to identify herself.

Finally, I assisted in steadying the boat as Ofc. Perez climbed in and threw a rope to Ofc. Medina to further steady the boat. Once the boat was more stable, Ofc. Perez continued to the corner of the boat where he physically assisted Godin to her feet, out of the boat, and half-way onto the pier. From there, Ofc. Medina was able to secure Godin's top half, and Ofc. Perez was able to place Godin's legs onto the pier as well. From there, Ofc. Perez got off the boat. Ofc. Medina and Ofc. Perez secured either hand while I cuffed Godin on the pier, checking for tightness, before standing her on her feet.

Ofc. Perez asked if Godin was injured to which she said no. Ofc. Perez photographed her to document any possible injury.

I searched Godin's belongings and discovered a glass pipe, known to me through training and experience to be common drug paraphernalia, especially with meth usage. I field-tested the pipe for meth, but did not get a definitive result. I packaged the glass pipe as drug paraphernalia and submitted it to Key West Police Department Records and

Investigation Details

On March 6th, 2025, Officer Randy Perez (uniformed), Officer Gustavo Medina (FTO plain clothes) and Probationary Officer Eliot Sharp (uniformed) responded to 201 William Street (Key West Bight Marina) in reference to a trespasser (later identified as Melissa Godin DOB 08/30/1982) who was drinking alcohol and smoking a lit cigarette by the fuel docks and refused to leave multiple times by the dockmaster and staff at the marina. Officer Perez made contact with Godin and was attempting to gather identification from her while she was committing violations of trespassing, littering and city marina rules at the dock. Godin obstructed lawful commands when she passively and actively resisted Officers Lawful commands. While in the process of attempting to detain Godin, she was physically taken to the ground of the dinghy and dock till she was placed in handcuffs and arrested. Photographs and body worn camera footage was activated by officers on scene and provided to me for evidentiary value. No injuries to officers, small scratch on her left foot area. BWC's were activated but his was placed aside prior to engagement so it would not get destroyed.
