Project Identification Number: 454101-1-52-01

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is developing the design for a roadway and drainage improvement project along SR 5/N Roosevelt Blvd/Truman Ave and Eisenhower Dr/Jose Marti Dr, in Key West, Monroe County.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Raising the roadway up to 6 inches.
- Localized pavement reconstruction:
 - Along Truman Ave
 - Along N Roosevelt Blvd
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Raising sea wall 12 inches
- Installing a water pump station system and upgrading storm drainage for mitigation of tidal flooding.
- Reconstruction of sidewalk and curb ramps.
- Reconstruction of Signalization features with new standard mast arm structures and pedestrian signal features.
- Installation of new signing and pavement markings.
- Reconstruction of decorative lighting features affected by the roadway improvements.

ESTIMATED PROJECT COST

\$14.8 million

PROJECT DATES

Work is expected to begin in fall 2027 and last about one year. Please note that the construction start date and duration is subject to change.

MUNICIPALITIES IN PROJECT AREA

- City of Key West
- Monroe County

POSSIBLE EFFECTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community. Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be impacted.

MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

During construction, full roadway closures with detours will be required. Temporary lane closures during non-peak hours and detours will affect traffic. Access to businesses, school and emergency responders will be maintained. Flaggers and traffic control officers will be used to control traffic flow.
