A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA,
APPROVING THE PAYMENT OF FLORIDA PORTS
COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP DUES FOR FY 14/15 IN
THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$20,500.00;
AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Florida Ports Council, is a nonprofit professional association for Florida's public seaports, which provides leadership, advocacy and information on seaport-related issues before the legislative and executive branches of state and federal government; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Ports Council additionally provides administrative support services on matters related to the Florida Seaport Transportation and Economic Development program (FSTED), which provides important funding for Key West port improvements;

WHEREAS, City staff finds membership in the Florida Ports Council to be beneficial to the port and to the citizens and visitors of Key West, and

recommends approval of this expenditure for council membership in FY 14-15;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an expenditure in the amount of \$20,500.00 for FY 14/15 membership in the Florida Ports Council is hereby approved.

Section 2: That a budget transfer in amount of \$2,000.00 from Account 001-4302-43-4600 to Account 001-4302-543-5100 is hereby approved.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
