-- Todd Sumner Quinn Arrest Narrative:

On 7/11/2022, at approximately 1000 hours, I (Ofc Betz) met with Ofc T Ane at Diver's Direct, 535 Greene St, in reference to her investigation into a theft case (22-3830).

Ofc Ane had sent out a BOLO for the suspect, who I believed was Todd S OQuinn (FL DL O250817682900), whom I had previous law enforcement encounters for similar crimes. I had contacted OQuinn's probation officer, who advised OQuinn had last checked in with her in May, 2022. A computer check revealed OQuinn had active warrants out of Monroe County and a revoked Florida Driver's license. I spoke to Ofc Ane about the case and wanted to see if there was any other video that showed a clearer picture of OQuinn and his tattoo on his right calf to confirm the identity.

Ofc Ane and I me with the manager, Arielle Halford, who was working on getting all the video from OQuinn's crimes. Halford advised OQuinn had stolen over \$25,000 of Spearguns and was trying to obtain all the videos to tie him to the crime.

Ofc Ane and I had informed Halford to immediately call us if he returned to the store.

At approximately 1214 hrs Ofc Stevens and I were dispatched to Diver's Direct due to OQuinn returning to the store. I arrived at 1219 hours, at which point OQuinn exited the store and drove off on a scooter. I was told by employees that OQuinn was in possession of two fishing rods as he left.

I canvassed the area and was told by a citizen that OQuinn was seen driving south on Elizabeth from Greene and that he was driving very fast. I aired the information over Channel 1.

Ofc Beerbower, who was in the area of Florida and Olivia, began to drive north on Florida, when he spotted OQuinn driving on a black scooter, bearing Florida tag MQEZ74. Ofc Beerbower told me, once OQuinn saw him, he veered into a parking spot and ran into the yard at of the property at Florida and Newton. Ofc Beerbower called for a perimeter in the area.

Ofc Stevens, who was in the area advised he was out with a possible suspect on Florida, and Petronia, but the male was not wearing a shirt. I responded to the location and observed Ofc Stevens speaking to OQuinn, who I immediately recognized. Ofc Stevens was wearing his Class B KWPD Uniform and I was wearing a KWPD Bicycle uniform, mounted on a clearly marked police bicycle. I ordered OQuinn to take sit down. OQuinn immediately turned and ran from Ofc Stevens and I.

OQuinn ran down Olivia and entered a yard on the south side of the road. I called to shift the perimeter south to Truman Ave.

Ofc Hartle advised he spotted OQuinn running into the yard at Rivas Electric. Ofc Hartle, Ofc Wallis and Ofc Beerbower took OQuinn into custody.

Ofc Beerbower had the scooter towed from the scene by Arnold's Towing.

I conducted a computer check of OQuinn and verified his Florida license was revoked and that his record met the criteria to be charged as a Habitual Traffic Offender asset forth in FSS 322.264.

Since OQuinn did resist Ofc Stevens and I by ignoring our lawful commands to stop and sit down by taking flight from us, OQuinn was in violation of FSS 843.02.

22-3934 Assist Road Patrol

On July 11, 2022, at approximately 1220 hours, Officers with the Key West Police Department were engaged in an active foot pursuit of a theft subject near the 1300 block of Petronia Street. A perimeter was established, and officers began canvassing the area for the suspect (see original report for details leading to the initial foot pursuit).

During the area canvass, at approximately 1230 hours, Officer Stevens approached a suspect matching the description of the theft suspect near 825 Georgia Street. The subject was described as a white male, no shirt, wearing a pair of Palegic swim style shorts. Moments later, the subject described above ran from Officer Stevens and a second foot pursuit was aired over KWPD Channel One. Upon hearing the pursuit, I, Detective Sealey, responded to the area to assist with the apprehension of the suspect.

Upon arrival, I took a stationary perimeter position near 1213 Truman Avenue. While on perimeter, Officer Wallis, who was holding a perimeter position as the intersection of Georgia Street and Truman Avenue, spotted the suspect on the 1200 block of Georgia Street. Officers responded to the area and apprehended the suspect, later identified as Todd O`Quinn, date of birth August 10, 1968, on the front porch area of 1215 Georgia Street. I had no involvement in the physical apprehension, interview(s), or any investigative involvement of this case (see original report and other supplemental reports for more information). This case is cleared as other.

On 7/11/22 at approximately 1220 hours, I responded to the 600 block of Elizabeth Street to assist officer Betz with a suspect who fled from the area.

Officer Betz radioed that the suspect, a white male wearing a white shirt and blue hat, had just stolen fishing gear from 535 Greene Street (Divers Direct) and was scene running East on Greene Street. Officer Betz observed the suspect get on a black scooter and ride South on Elizabeth Street at high speed. As I was responding to the area, I observed the suspect riding the scooter South on the 700 block of Florida Street. As I approached in my vehicle from the North, the suspect observed me and immediately pulled to the side of the street and dismounted the scooter. As I moved closer, I observed the suspect run into the back yard of the residence on the corner of Newton Street and Florida Street. I radioed to dispatch and informed them where I was and where the suspect was last seen. I directed Officers to establish a perimeter to try and contain the suspect in the area. As the perimeter was being established, I overheard Officer Stevens say he was possibly in contact with the suspect at the corner of Georgia Street and Petronia Street. Moments later I heard Officer Stevens say he was pursuing the suspect on foot, and he was running on Olivia Street toward White Street. Officer Hartle radioed that he observed the suspect run into the yard at 916 George Street (Rivas Electric) and he had not exited the yard. I responded to the area and began searching the yard where the suspect was last seen. Moments later, I heard Officer Hartle yelling commands to "Show me your hands!" and "Get on the ground!". I ran to assist Officer Hartle and as I approached him, I observed the suspect standing next to several garbage cans with Officer Hartle displaying his Taser. As I moved closer, the suspect had his hands extended out, but would not comply with Officer Hartle's command to get down on the ground. As I moved closer, it appeared to me that the suspect was attempting to position himself to possibly flee again. As Officer Hartle yelled commands, the suspect stepped forward but would not get down on the ground. At that point, while facing the suspect, I grabbed him by the shoulders and pulled him toward my direction. As I did this, I directed the suspect to the ground to attempt to control him and prevent him from fleeing. Once on the ground, I commanded the suspect to put his hands behind his back and he complied. Officer Hansell handcuffed the suspect and assisted him to his feet. Officer Hansell escorted this suspect to her vehicle and placed him inside.

Once the suspect was secured, I returned to Florida Street and assisted with towing the suspect's scooter.

In my haste, I failed to activate my BWC for this event.

On July 11, 2022, Ofc Betz and I were dispatched to "Divers Direct", 535 Greene St, Key West, Florida, in reference to a theft suspect being on the premises. Dispatch advised that the subject is the suspect in KWPD Case# 22-3830. Ofc Betz arrived prior to me and he gave a suspect description over Channel 1, advising that the suspect had left the store and went east on Greene St. He then advised that the suspect was traveling south on Elizabeth St on a black moped.

While I was driving to the area to search for the suspect, Ofc Beerbower announced that he had located the suspect near the intersection of Florida St and Newton St and that the suspect had run into a yard. Ofc Beerbower requested officers at the intersections Petronia St/Georgia St and Newton St/Georgia St to establish a perimeter. As I approached the intersection of Petronia St and Georgia St, I saw a white male walking south on Georgia St. The male was shirtless, but otherwise matched the description of the suspect. I advised that I had seen a possible suspect and I turned around to speak with him. I stopped in front of 825 Georgia St and exited my police car to speak to him, telling him to stop. I asked him if he had just been in Divers Direct and he said no, he had just left a friend's house. Ofc Betz arrived and told the subject to sit down. The suspect then took off running at speed south on Georgia St and I pursued on foot. He then turned west onto the 1200 block of Olivia St and Ofc Betz and I followed. The suspect then ran into the driveway of 1212 Olivia St. Ofc Betz and I followed, but were stopped by a locked gate. I looked over the fence of 1214 Olivia St and I saw the suspect running south through the property.

Shortly after, another perimeter was set up south of my location. I relocated to the intersection of Georgia St and Olivia St. I heard Ofc Hartle announce that he had located the suspect and shortly after, the suspect was in custody.

The suspect had fled on a scooter and was last seen wearing a blue visor and a pigeon shirt with fishing poles.

I was in my marked patrol vehicle and patrolling for the suspect when Officer Beerbauer stated he possibly had the scooter on the 1300 block of Newton St.

I went to the intersection of Georgia St and Newtons St for a perimeter. The suspect was seen jumping fences and last seen in the area of Truman Ave and Georgia St. I observed officers running after the suspect on foot west. I got in my patrol vehicle and went to White St. down to Truman Ave and turned East onto Truman Ave. As I got to Georgia I saw officers running toward the rear of 1215 Truman Ave.

When I got out of my patrol vehicle after parking on Georgia St, I saw multiple officers attempting to take a white male matching the suspect description into custody. As I got to them, the officers had the suspect face down and had pulled his left arm behind his back. I was able to rotate his right arm behind his back and I handcuffed the suspect (double-locked).

I stood the suspect up on to his feet as he continued to yell and cuss at officers on scene. Sgt CF Sims and I escorted the suspect to the rear of my patrol vehicle. I searched the suspect and placed him in the backseat of my patrol vehicle. My BWC was already activated. I activated the in-car cameras for transport to Monroe County Detention Center without further incident.
