

RESOLUTION NO. 12-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RATIFYING AN EMERGENCY PURCHASE APPROVED BY THE CITY MANAGER IN EXCESS OF \$20,000 AS ALLOWED UNDER SECTION 2-797(2) OF CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF SURVEYING SERVICES TO DOCUMENT TROPICAL STORM EROSION ACCESS AND DOCUMENT DAMAGE TO FOUR CITY BEACHES, SAID PROCUREMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,874 TO ATKINS NORTH AMERICA; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, during the weekend of August 27-29, 2012, Tropical Storm Isaac inflicted more than \$1,000,000.00 worth of erosion damage upon four city beaches and related berms; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has included the City of Key West in his Major Disaster Declaration of October 19, 2012 [DR-4084]; and

WHEREAS, the disaster declaration makes eligible the reimbursement of certain disaster recovery costs; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, as part of its disaster recovery grant process requires documentation of such damage, demonstrating that which is attributable to this specific disaster; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager acted without delay, utilizing emergency powers authorized under Section 2-797(2) of the City's Code of Ordinances, to procure erosion surveys in anticipation of an immediately forthcoming visit by FEMA to assess damages and issue disaster recovery grants; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-797(2) of the City's Code of Ordinances requires the City Commission to ratify such emergency purchases at its next scheduled meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Commission, in accordance with Section 2-797(2) of the City of Key West Code of Ordinances, hereby ratifies the City Manager's emergency authorization for the procurement in the amount of \$24,874.00 from Atkins North America, for surveying services to document the extent of erosion damage upon Smathers, Rest, Dog and South beaches resulting from Tropical Storm Isaac.

Section 2: That necessary budget transfers are authorized.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the clerk of the commission.
