A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT TO FLORIDA KEYS MEDIA TO CONDUCT THE PET MASQUERADE AT THE TRUMAN WATERFRONT AMPHITHEATER FUNDRAISER FOR THE MONROE SHERIFF'S OFFICE WEDNESDAY, ANIMAL FARM ON OCTOBER 22, 2025, FROM 5:00 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CITY CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC **BEVERAGES** WITHIN ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE AN

WHEREAS, Florida Keys Media has applied to the city for a Special Event permit for the Pet Masquerade at the Truman Waterfront Amphitheater between the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 22, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor

biodegradable. Vendor/lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That Florida Keys Media is hereby granted a Special Event permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Florida Keys Media is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That Florida Keys Media must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. That Florida Keys Media will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1)

recycling container for everyone (1) trash container will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. Florida Keys Media will be responsible for the rental fee of five hundred \$(500.00) dollars plus tax. In addition, Florida Keys Media acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
