A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), AWARDING THE BID OF ALL IN ONE FIRE, INC IN RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #24-009 FIRE PUMPS REPLACEMENT KEY WEST HISTORIC SEAPORT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$209,123.47; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, three bids were opened on May 2, 2024, in response to ITB #24-009, all bids were found to be responsive after clarification from all three firms; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of May 8, 2024, the Key West Bight Management District Board made a recommendation to the CRA to award a contract in accordance with documents contained in the ITB to All In One Fire, Inc through Resolution KWB #24-13; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of All In One Fire, Inc is hereby awarded in the amount of \$209,123.47, in response to ITB #24-009, the terms and conditions of which are incorporated herein.

Section 2: That funding for this project is budgeted in

Infrastructure Fund Accounts 405-7503-575-6300 (Project No. KB1507) and 405-7506-575-6300 (Project No. KB1507)

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
