A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA) AWARDING THE BID OF D.L. PORTER CONSTRUCTORS, INC. FOR THE KEY WEST HISTORIC SEAPORT COMMON AREA ENHANCEMENT PROJECT - PHASE 1, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$576,702.31; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN CONFORMANCE WITH BID DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2015 four bids were opened in response to ITB #15-004, for Key West Historic Seaport Common Area Enhancement Project - Phase 1, and the bids were determined to be responsive; and

WHEREAS, City/CRA staff recommended award of the bid to D.L. Porter Constructors, Inc., which submitted the lowest bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of D.L. Porter Constructors, Inc. for the Key West Historic Seaport Common Area Enhancement Project - Phase 1, in a total amount not to exceed \$576,702.31 is hereby awarded in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the Invitation to Bid number 15-004 and response thereto.

Section 2: That the City Manager, upon consent of the City Attorney, is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the bid documents on behalf of the CRA/City of Key West.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
