

RESOLUTION NO. 24-026

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE KEY WEST POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE MATRIX GYM EQUIPMENT FROM COMMERCIAL FITNESS PRODUCTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$59,235.55, USING FEDERAL FORFEITURE FUNDS, PURSUANT TO KEY WEST CODE OF ORDINANCES, SEC. 2-797(4)(b) - BEST INTEREST; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET AMENDMENTS AND TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(4)(B) permits the purchase of goods and services if in the opinion of the city manager exceptional circumstances exist to exempt a purchase from the competitive bid requirements of this subdivision for the best interests of the city, the city manager shall place a resolution before the city commission for approval of such exemption; and

WHEREAS, City staff obtained three price quotes for commercial grade fitness equipment, with Commercial Fitness Products providing the lowest bid, and City staff believes Commercial Fitness Products provides reliable, state of the

art equipment with a robust warranty; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase of Matrix gym equipment from Commercial Fitness Products, in an amount of \$59,235.55 is hereby approved for the Key West Police Department's Fitness Center, pursuant to Section 2-797(4)(b) of the Key West Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: That funding in the amount of \$59,235.55 is available in Federal Forfeiture Reserve Funds Account 172-2113-521-9803 and is hereby authorized to fully fund this procurement. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager or Designee is authorized to execute necessary documents for this procurement, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication

by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
