A. Personnel. \$18,032

- Overtime for travel to training for 4 marine officers. Trainings are 40-hour week courses, so only travel from Key West to locations in the southeast will be at overtime rate.
 - Average overtime wage of \$46 an hour. 4 officers x 12 hours overtime for travel x 4 trainings = \$8832
- Overtime for exercises conducted in conjunction with the U.S. Coast Guard. Exercises of 20 hours in duration total over 24 months.
 - Average overtime wage of \$46 an hour. 10 officers x 20 hours overtime = \$9200

B. Fringe Benefits. \$13,524

- 75 % of wage for hours detailed above. \$13,524

C. Travel. \$27,200

Travel expenses for 4 marine officers to attend 4 trainings including: Seaport Security Antiterrorism Training Program (SSATP), Commercial Vessel Boarding Training Program (CVBTP), Boat Operator's Antiterrorism Program, one course to be announced (approved topic only). 2 of these courses include room and board in their tuition, those expenses are detailed in category "Other" below.
