REQUEST: The applicant is requesting removal of the Seagrape tree.

NOTES: There is significant decay near the base of the stem. The roots receive constant abuse from car tires. The canopy is a bit unbalanced. Seagrapes are amongst the most hardy/resilient of all Keys trees. What is most troubling is the tree abuse that took place just inside the gate. It appears to be a Buttonwood tree. Urban Forestry would be remis to not include this incident on the application.
