A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ("CRA"), ACKNOWLEDGING AND ACCEPTING FOR CONSIDERATION THE RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE KEY WEST BIGHT MANAGEMENT DISTRICT BOARD ("BIGHT BOARD") SET FORTH IN "KWBB RESOLUTION 26-13"; DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADDRESS THE RECOMMENDATIONS; DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ASSESS THE FEASIBILITY AND COSTS OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS AND REPORT BACK TO THE CRA WITHIN TWO MONTHS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2026 the Key West Bight Management District Board ("KWBB") approved Key West Bight Board Resolution No. 26-13 setting forth their recommendations and requests to ensure Reef Relief maintains tenancy within the Key West Bight and to incorporate their requested design modifications into the Thompson Fish House to support continued marine science education, summer camp programming, and museum operations; and

WHEREAS, the Caroline Street Corridor and Bahama Village Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") acknowledges the recommendations of the Bight Board, and also desires to maintain reef relief as a tenant; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the CRA hereby acknowledges and accepts for consideration the recommendations of the Bight Board set

forth in "KWBB Resolution No. 26-13", attached hereto and made a part hereof of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Manager is hereby directed to address the recommendations and requests set forth in this resolution and coordinate with City staff, as appropriate, in response to the recommendations and requests of the Bight Board in KWBB 26-13.

Section 3: That the City Manager is hereby further directed to assess the feasibility and costs associated with the recommendations and requests of the Bight Board set forth in KWBB 26-13, and to report back to the Commission with the results of that assessment within two (2) months of the adoption of this Resolution.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Board.
