Original Narrative By Ivan Golovanov, 12/06/25 03:07

On 12/06/2025 at approximately 0100 hours, multiple officers and I, Officer Golovanov, were on a routine patrol at the intersection of Duval Street and Charles Street, wearing full KWPD Class B uniforms, when we were flagged down by security personnel from "Rick's Bar" (202 Duval St.).

At the entrance to the second floor of "Rick's Bar," I observed a commotion between multiple security personnel of the establishment and a white male (Matthew T. Postmus, DOB: 07/18/1989). Matthew was actively fighting multiple security personnel while they were trying to escort Matthew from the property. At this moment, multiple officers and I attempted to handcuff Matthew; however, Matthew continued resisting and was now fighting our attempts to handcuff him.

Matthew continued resisting to the point that Sergeant Waite had to drive stunned Matthew in a lower back area (see Sgt. Waite's supplemental report for greater details). Matthew was eventually handcuffed and then walked to the intersection of Duval Street and Charles Street, where my patrol vehicle was parked.

I relocated to "Rick's Bar" office, where I was provided with video footage of the incident. I observed Matthew being

escorted from the second floor of "Rick's Bar." However, he stopped before reaching the stairs and began to dance instead of leaving the property. I saw security personnel repeatedly trying to remove Matthew from the premises. He continued to refuse, eventually escalating to a physical confrontation with the security staff. It took five people to finally escort him from the property. Notably, a large number of patrons were present during this incident.

None of the security personnel pressed battery charges against Matthew; however, they were willing to press trespassing charges.

I returned to Matthew and informed him that he was under arrest. I searched Matthew at the hood of my patrol vehicle while the Fleet camera was operating. Matthew was placed in the back of my patrol vehicle.

I transported Matthew to Lower Keys Medical Center for medical clearance. After Matthew was medically cleared, I transported him to MCDC without incident.

During this incident, my BWC, In-car, and Fleet cameras were operated and uploaded to Evidence.com.

Video of Matthew's actions inside "Rick's Bar" was also uploaded to Evidence.com.

Based on the facts and evidence in this case, I believe that Matthew T. Postmus violated FSS 810.09-1a1 trespassing. Matthew willfully and intentionally refused to leave the property after multiple orders from security personnel, to the point that security personnel had to use force to escort him from the establishment.

Based on the facts and evidence in this case, I believe that Matthew T. Postmus violated FSS 509.143 disorderly conduct on the premises of the establishment. Matthew was actively fighting five security guards inside the establishment while a large number of patrons were present. Matthew's actions posed a threat to the safety of other customers and staff members.

Based on the facts and evidence in this case, I believe that Matthew T. Postmus violated FSS 843.02, resisting without violence. Matthew wilfully and intentionally resisted multiple full uniform KYPD officers and fought our attempts to handcuff him.
