Utility liens were filed on July 25, 2012 for \$425.32-storm water; \$1,670.52-garbage; and \$2,046.09-sewer = \$4,141.93.

On February 13, 2007, an application for an electrical permit was made to “connect power to house from temp pole” due to code case #07-128. Kit Roberts was electrical contractor of record. Permit #07-684 was not picked up nor was it paid for and the work was never completed. The permit expired and was cancelled. On May 25, 2010, an application for an electrical permit was made to “extend permit #07-684 for inspection purposes only (connect power to house from temp pole-code violation)” by property owner. Permit was put on hold due to \$2,476.00 utilities delinquency.
