A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING WE CYCLE, INC. AND THE KEY WEST ART AND HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INC. TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL ZOMBIE BICYCLE RIDE EVENT STARTING AT EAST MARTELLO TOWERS AND ENDING AT THE KEY WEST TRUMAN WATERFRONT COFFEE BUTLER AMPHITHEATER ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2023, FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 8:00 P.M.; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREET THEREOF FOR THE ZOMBIE RIDE ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2023 FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 8:00 P.M.; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS We Cycle, Inc. and the Key West Art & Historical Society, Inc. request permission to hold the annual Zombie Ride on Sunday, October 22, 2023, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law.”

SECTION 2. “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore, commits to refrain from the use or distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic

utensils and “to go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City”

SECTION 3. That We Cycle, Inc. and the Key West Art & Historical Society, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct the annual Zombie Ride on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. We Cycle, Inc. and the Key West Art & Historical Society, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That the Zombie ride will start at Fort East Martello going to South Roosevelt Boulevard to Bertha Street, to Atlantic Boulevard, to Reynolds Street, to South Street, to Duval Street, turning left on Southard Street into the Truman Waterfront, ending at the Coffee Butler Amphitheater.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
