A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, SPONSORING A MARTIN LUTHER KING CELEBRATION AND MARCH ON MONDAY, JANUARY 16, 2017, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF NOON AND 6:00 P.M. AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS FOR THE MARCH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to provide a Martin Luther King March on the date and times herein described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City of Key West hereby sponsors a Martin Luther King Celebration and March on Monday, January 16, 2017, between noon to 6:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. That all provisions of the Code of Ordinances with respect to a march on the City right-of-way shall be observed.

SECTION 3. That the celebration will begin at the Nelson English Park (Martin Luther King Community Center) Thomas and Catherine Streets immediately followed by the march beginning on the corner of Thomas and Catherine Streets.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
