## -- William Pierce Horne Arrest Narrative:

On 2/10/2025 at approximately 0630 hours I, Ofc Standerwick, responded to Trumbo Point Naval Air Station in reference to the Naval Air Station Police investigating a drug call at 525 Ricketts Circle vacation cottages. NAS advised one of their patrol units were at a cottage where the occupants, later identified as William Horne (Defendant) and his wife Alleigh Greene, were actively smoking marijuana on the front porch.

Upon arrival with Ofc Stutz and Perez we met with NAS Police officers Alesia Harmon and Ofc Oscar Valdez, who advised they were on patrol when they passed the cottage they saw and smelled marijuana from two individuals on the porch. They attempted to speak with the individuals however when they did the occupants retreated into the cottage and would not answer the door. I knocked on the door and I could see the Defendant inside the cottage on the bed. I continued to knock and Ofc Stutz and I circled the trailer in an attempt to make contact with the occupants. When we returned to the front of the cottage Mrs. Greene was exiting the trailer. I met Mrs. Greene at the door and explained that we needed to talk to her in reference to a complaint. While she was escorted off the trailer steps the Defendant could be heard yelling from the inside of the trailer that that is his wife, and we can't talk to her. The Defendant then emerged from the trailer in a very agitated state which was displayed in him yelling profanities at me and the other officers on scene. The Defendant rapidly descended the trailer steps, and I immediately told him to step back. The Defendant did not listen to my command to step back and proceeded to get right in front of my face continually yelling at me to stop talking to his wife. At that time, I took my right hand and pushed the Defendant away from me to create a safe distance. I again warned the Defendant to step back and not to get in my face. The Defendant continued to get aggravated and was continually yelling at me to not talk to his wife. It was at this point the Defendant became more aggressive, and he approached me with balled up fists and he once again got in my personal safety zone. I told the Defendant to back off and I used both hands and placed them on his chest and pushed him away from me. Ofc. Stutz and Perez were located behind the Defendant, and they restrained the Defendant and took him to the ground. Once on the ground I handcuffed the Defendant. Sgt. Siracuse was notified, and he responded to the scene. NAS police preformed an administrative search of the trailer finding drug paraphernalia. These items were placed into property under this case number. The Defendant complained of being injured and Key West Rescue responded, and he was taken to Lower Keys Hospital for treatment. While receiving treatment hospital staff informed me, he was at the hospital with the MCSO sheriff office on an arrest on 2/3/25 for improper display of a firearm. The hospital cleared the Defendant for transportation to the jail where he was charged with resisting with violence.

At the jail the Defendant was given an opportunity to explain his actions in the form of a letter. The Defendant accepted the invitation and wrote a letter asking for forgiveness for his actions as he is hard of hearing from years in the military.

On 02/10/2025, at 0624 hours, Ofc. Standerwick, Ofc. Stutz and I (Ofc. R. Perez) were dispatched to 525 Ricketts Cir. in reference to a suspicious incident.

Upon arrival, NAS Police were knocking on a door to a trailer trying to make contact with the residents. NAS Police advised that the residents were outside smoking marijuana. A female later identified by her Florida DL as Alleigha Church Green answer the door. We asked her to walk toward an NAS Police Officer. A male later identified by his North Carolina DL as William Horne came out of the trailer screaming at all of us. Horne charged toward Ofc. Standerwick in an aggressive manner coming within a foot of Ofc. Standerwick. Ofc. Standerwick pushed Horne back to get him away from him. Horne continued to yell at Ofc. Standerwick and approached him again with closed fists. Ofc. Standerwick pushed Horne back and Ofc. Stutz used a modified leg sweep to take Horne to the ground.

Horne landed in the prone position and we attempted to place him into handcuffs. We gave Horne several loud verbal commands to stop tensing up and to place his hands behind his back and Horne refused to comply. We then placed Horne into handcuffs. Horne was rolled on his side into the recovery position.

Horne was then transported by Rescue 1 to Lower Keys Medical Center.

On Monday, February 10, 2025, at approximately 0630 hours, Ofc. Standerwick, Ofc. R. Perez and I (Ofc. Stutz) were dispatched to Trumbo Pont Navy Base to assist NAS Police who advised they observed subjects on base using marijuana.

On arrival, we were directed to Cabin 6 at 525 Ricketts Circle where NAS Police Units were attempting to make contact with the occupants. We spoke to NAS Officers Alesia Harmon and Oscar Valdez who advised the subject inside was refusing to come to the door. NAS Officer Harmon advised she observed the occupants smoking on the porch and could smell the odor of burned marijuana. Ofc. Standerwick and I attempted contact but were also ignored. Ofc. Standerwick and I then circled the trailer in an attempt to make contact with any of the occupants. As we circled back, a female, later identified as Alleigha Church Green, exited the trailer. Ofc. Standerwick requested she step away from the trailer, and she complied. I then observed a male, later identified as William Horne, exit the trailer screaming profanities at Ofc. Standerwick and demanding he stop talking to his wife. I observed Horne rapidly approach Ofc. Standerwick, entering his reactionary gap, and yelling that he didn't know who he was messing with. Ofc. Standerwick gave Horne several loud verbal commands to step back, to which Horne ignored and stepped forward. Ofc. Standerwick pushed Horne away with one hand and stepped back, increasing the distance between them and continued to order him to stay back. Horne became more aggressive and tensed his body and balled his fists. Horne continued to scream at everyone in the area and eventually stepped toward Ofc. Standerwick, aggressively with his fists clenched. Ofc. Standerwick pushed Horne backward as he charged in. Horne stepped backwards into me and I took him to the ground using a modified leg sweep. Horne landed in a prone position and pulled his arms under himself. Ofc. Perez, Ofc. Standerwick, and I pulled his arms free and placed him into handcuffs. Horne was placed in the rescue position and Key West Rescue and Sgt. Siracuse were called to the scene.

While on scene, NAS Police received authorization from the Navy Base Commander to conduct an administrative search of the trailer, due to a high volume of complaints that had been generated over the past several days. NAS Police conducted the search and turned over the following items:

11.1 grams of green leafy substance (FTP Marijuana)

1x Grinder with residue

1x Tray with residue

1x Mason Jar with residue

I collected the items from NAS Police and later entered them into Key West Police Property and Evidence Section for destruction.
