A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING TRANSFER OF FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00 FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE SURTAX 101-1900-519.94, RESERVE FUND, TO THE PROJECT RECREATIONAL ACCOUNT FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BOCCE COURTS LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF ATLANTIC BOULEVARD AND WHITE STREET; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Southernmost Bocce League, Inc. has proposed a "joint effort," with the City to construct seven new ADA-compliant bocce courts, and improvements to the bocce court vicinity; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the proposed project is a cost-effective way to enhance the safety, accessibility and general enjoyment of the citizens of Key West, and would be an appropriate expenditure from the Infrastructure Surtax Reserve fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a transfer of funds in the amount of \$25,000.00 from the Infrastructure Surtax Fund Reserves 101-1900-519.94 to the appropriate recreational project account in Fund 101 is hereby authorized.

Section 2: That the transferred funds shall be used expressly for improvements/reconstruction of the bocce courts and vicinity, located at the corner of Atlantic Boulevard and White Street.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
