A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE AWARD OF THE BID OF SMITH INDUSTRIES, INC. d/b/a SMITH FENCE COMPANY IN RESPONSE TO ITB 12-029 IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,445,302.49, FOR ORNAMENTAL FENCING REPLACEMENT AT THE NAVY MOLE PIER; APPROVING NECESSARY BUDGET AMENDMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West leases from the United States of America through the Department of the Navy a section of the Navy Outer Mole Pier for the specific purpose of cruise ship berthing; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of rent payments to the Navy for use of the Mole Pier, the City has agreed to perform certain in-kind projects, including the work contemplated in RFP 12-029: Ornamental fencing Replacement; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this project will be covered as an in-kind service through the Navy Mole Lease funds; and

WHEREAS, in order to accommodate a request by the U.S. Navy to expedite the project, a Notice of Award was issued on July 20, 2012, and the contractor provided all required bonds, insurances and powers of attorney by August 3, 2012; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the award of bid to Smith Industries, Inc. d/b/a Smith Fence Company is hereby ratified in an amount not to exceed \$1,445,302.49 as delineated in the response to ITB 12-029, the terms and conditions of which are incorporated herein.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any contractual documents, with the advice and consent of the City Attorney, that are consistent with ITB #12-029 and the approval granted herein.

Section 3: That necessary budget transfers from Navy Reserves Account #602-1900-519-9800 to Navy Repairs and Maintenance Account #602-1900-519-4600 are hereby authorized.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
