

RESOLUTION NO. 21-124

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF  
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDED  
THE BID OF ARNOLD'S AUTO & MARINE REPAIR,  
INC. IN RESPONSE TO RFP 004-21, FOR  
WRECKER/TOWING SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE  
CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT  
UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY;  
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2021, the City issued RFP 004-21  
entitled "Wrecker/Towing Services"; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2021, the City opened two responses  
to RFP #004-21, and an evaluation committee met on May 10,  
2021, at a publicly noticed meeting to review the proposals;  
and

WHEREAS, the evaluation committee ranked Arnold's Auto  
& Marine Repair, Inc. as the bid most responsive to the RFP  
criteria, scoring 290 of 300 possible points by the evaluation  
committee, and recommends acceptance of the proposal from  
Arnold's Auto and Marine Repair, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Arnold's Auto & Marine  
Repair, Inc., is hereby awarded in response to RFP 004-21.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract in substantial conformance with documents contained in the RFP #004-21, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney, and the approval granted herein.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.


