#### Narrative

#### NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

Officers attempted to handcuff Jenkins, who began to physically resist by pulling away and attempting to head-butt Ofc. Adorno. Jenkins was taken to the ground, where he continued to physically fight and actively resist. Jenkins refused to follow verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. Ofc. Vanderhoof delivered a cartridge on "drive stun" to Jenkins' lower back. Jenkins placed one arm behind his back, refused to place his other arm behind his back and continued actively resisting. Ofc. Vanderhoof delivered a second cartridge on "drive stun" to Jenkins' lower back, at which time he complied and placed his hands behind his back. As Jenkins was placed into the rear of the patrol vehicle, he continued to resist and began to physically fight again. Jenkins began kicking at Ofc. Vanderhoof, striking him in the upper thigh area. Sergeant Kouri removed Jenkins from the vehicle and placed him back on the ground in a controlled manner. After a brief struggle and several more

direct verbal commands, Jenkins complied and was placed back into the rear of the patrol car. Jenkins sustained multiple small lacerations and abrasions while actively fighting officers. The time of each small injury cannot be determined.
