A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A PURCHASING EXCEPTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO ALLOW AN INCREASE OF \$25,000.00 IN CUMULATIVE EXPENDITURES DURING FY 16-17 TO TEN-8 FIRE EQUIPMENT (TEN-8), FOR ADDITIONAL REPAIR AND TESTING SERVICES; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET AMENDMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 2-796 of the Code of Ordinances requires competitive bidding for purchases or services in excess of \$20,000.00; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 16-303, the City Commission approved purchasing exceptions for a number of sole source and/or blanket purchase orders in excess of \$20,000.00, including Ten-8; and

WHEREAS, Ten-8 supplies certain sole source or specialized repair and service parts for City fire apparatus, which are essential to the health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Key West; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager finds that pursuant to section 2-797(4), it is in the best interest of the City to authorize increase the amount of authorized expenditures previously approved in Resolution 16-303 for Ten-8.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an increase of \$25,000.00 to the expenditure of funds previously authorized in Resolution No. 16-303, to a total of \$65,000.00, is hereby approved for Ten-8 in accordance with Key West City Code of Ordinances section 2-797(4)(b).

Section 3: That a necessary budget transfer within the Fire Department FY 16-17 Budget, from account #001-2201-522-64 to 001-2201-522-46, is hereby authorized.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
