**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST,  
FLORIDA, ACCEPTING AND ADOPTING THE CITY  
OF KEY WEST COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION  
PLAN; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, tragically, twenty-five (25) people were killed in roadway crashes within the City of Key West during the years from 2016 through 2020 according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration reporting; and

WHEREAS, measures to make roadways within the City of Key West safer for all users, including those who are most physically vulnerable, such as seniors, youth, and people with disabilities, will further encourage people of all ages and abilities to walk, bike, and take transit; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 20-009 directed staff to work with the County and State to create policies and goals for right-of-way projects to incorporate "Complete and Sustainable Streets" and the target of "Vision Zero", setting a "Vision Zero" goal to achieve zero collision-caused right-of-way fatalities and serious injuries by the year 2035; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West City Commission approved Resolution 23-228 authorizing a grant agreement with the Federal Highway Administration division of the United States Department of Transportation for funding a City of Key West Comprehensive Safety Action Plan in support of "Vision Zero";

and

WHEREAS, Resolution 24-243 authorized the City Manager to execute a contract with University of Florida Transportation Institute (UFTI) to support the drafting of a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, UFTI researchers worked with Safety Action Plan Task Force stakeholders representing local police, EMS, and transportation; Monroe County schools and transportation; Florida Department of Transportation; and community advocates to evaluate proven safety countermeasures; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 09-024 created the Sustainability Advisory Board to advise and assist the City Commission in efforts to make City operations and the community more sustainable; and

WHEREAS, the Sustainability Advisory Board passed Resolution SAB 26-01 recommending the City Commission accept and adopt the Key West Comprehensive Safety Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission finds that accepting and adopting the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan will enhance the health and safety of residents of the City

of Key West.

Section 2: That the City Commission of the City of Key West accepts and adopts the City of Key West Comprehensive Safety Action Plan.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
