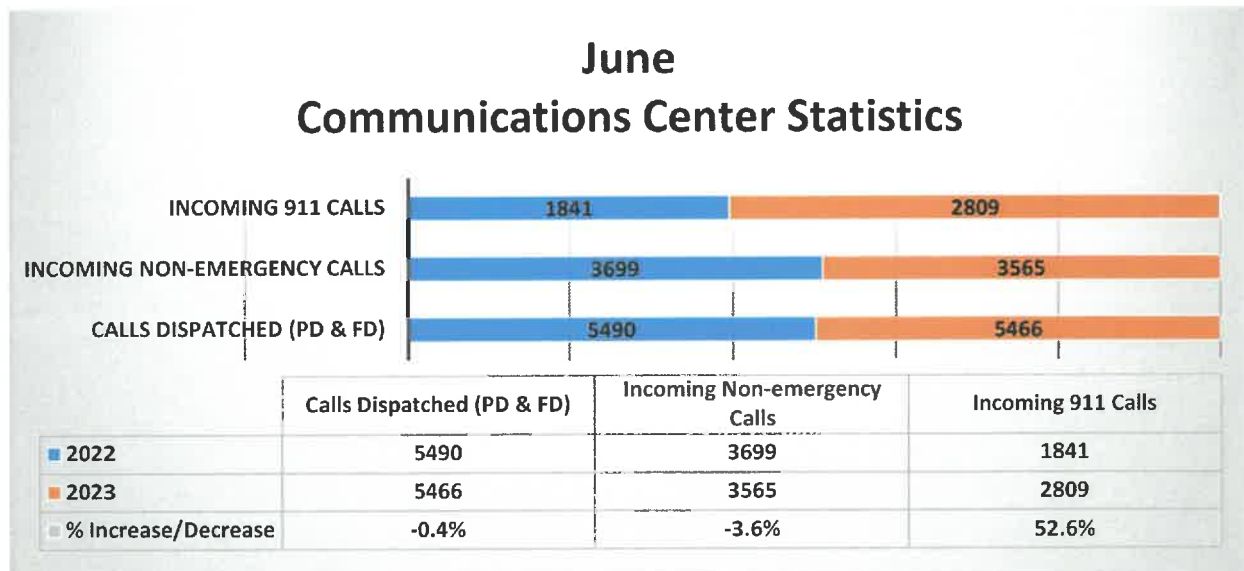
Subject: June 2023 Key West Police Department Report

In June 2023, the Key West Police Department’s Communication Center received 6374 calls into the dispatch center. Those calls generated 5466 calls for service for police/fire/rescue. Compared to June 2022, we experienced a 52.6% increase in 911 calls, a 3.6% decrease in non-emergency calls, and a .04 decrease in calls for service for police/fire/rescue.

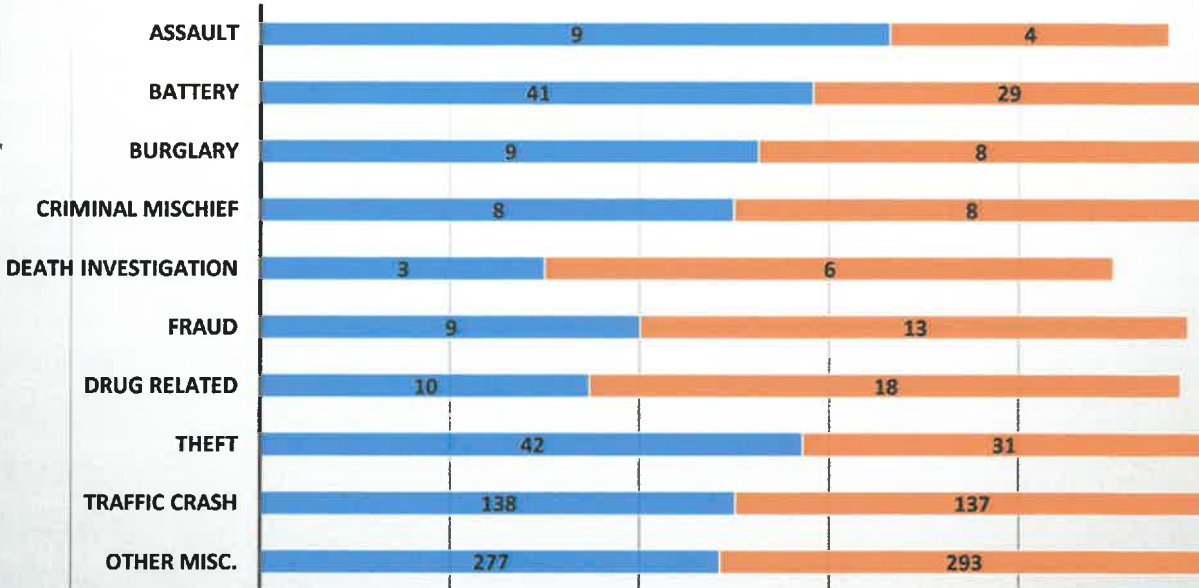
Officers completed 547 police reports and 117 arrests were made. Compared to June 2022, police reports increased by .18% and arrests increased by 21.9%.

A total of 768 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 130 citations and 125 written warnings.

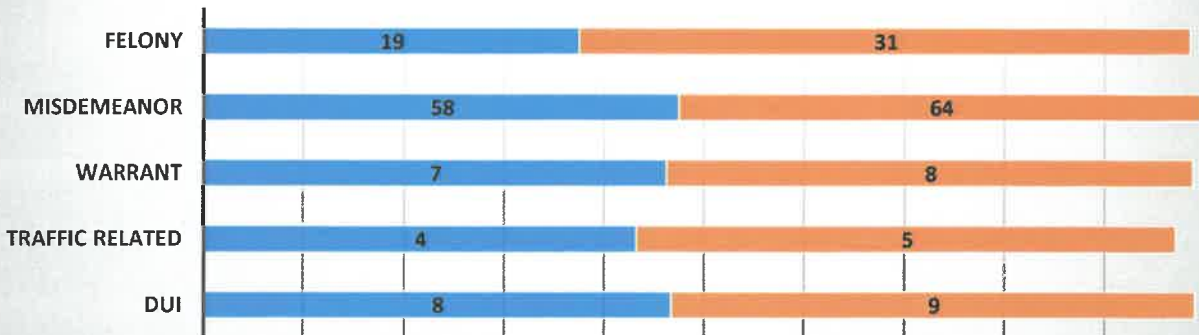
