A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT, INSTALLATION AND CONFIGURATION OF FAST FARE EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES FROM SPX TECHNOLOGIES INC, DBA GENFARE LLC, AS DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED PROPOSAL, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$370,000.00, ON A SOLE SOURCE BASIS AND IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(1) AND 2-797(4)(b) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND BUDGET TRANSFERS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West has utilized Genfare's collection system since 2001; and

WHEREAS, Genfare officially ceased manufacturing the Odyssey and Odyssey Plus fareboxes on December 31, 2022, including spare and repair parts; and

WHEREAS, the current Odyssey fareboxes, used to sell bus passes and collect fare payments, are outdated and obsolete, necessitating replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's Office recommends the procurement of Fast Fare equipment and accessories to replace outdated and obsolete equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$370,000; and

WHEREAS, this acquisition will be fully reimbursed under FDOT 5311 Capital Grant - PTGA G3101 at 100%, incurring zero cost to the City;

WHEREAS, the Fast Fare fareboxes are designed to evolve and adapt to new technology, compatible with Genfare Link, allowing it to grow alongside the department's goal of introducing debit/credit card payment on the bus, tap-to-pay, and more;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Commission hereby authorizes the purchase of Fast Fare farebox equipment and accessories to replace the obsolete Odyssey farebox equipment, on a sole source and best interest basis pursuant to Key West Code of Ordinances sections 2-797(1) and 2-797(4)(b), in an amount not to exceed \$370,000.00.

Section 2: That the Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any necessary documents and budget transfers and/or adjustments, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
