An application was received for the removal of **1 Bottlebrush tree and 1 Mahogany tree**. A site inspection was done on March 20, 2013 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Mahogany (*Swietenia mahoagoni*)



Diameter: 2.5"

Location: 80% (no issues right now but as the tree grows, it will impact the foundation of the house)

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 80% (good health)

Total Average Value = 86%

Value x Diameter = **2 replacement caliper (dbh) inches**

Tree Species: Bottlebrush Tree (Callistemon sp.)



Diameter: total 32"

Location: 80%

Species: 50% (not on protected tree list or not protected tree list)

Condition: 20% (good health)

Total Average Value = 50%

Value x Diameter = **16 replacement caliper (dbh) inches**



Recommendations: Recommend approval of the removal of 1 mahogany tree and 1 bottlebrush tree. To be replace with a total of 18 caliper inches.

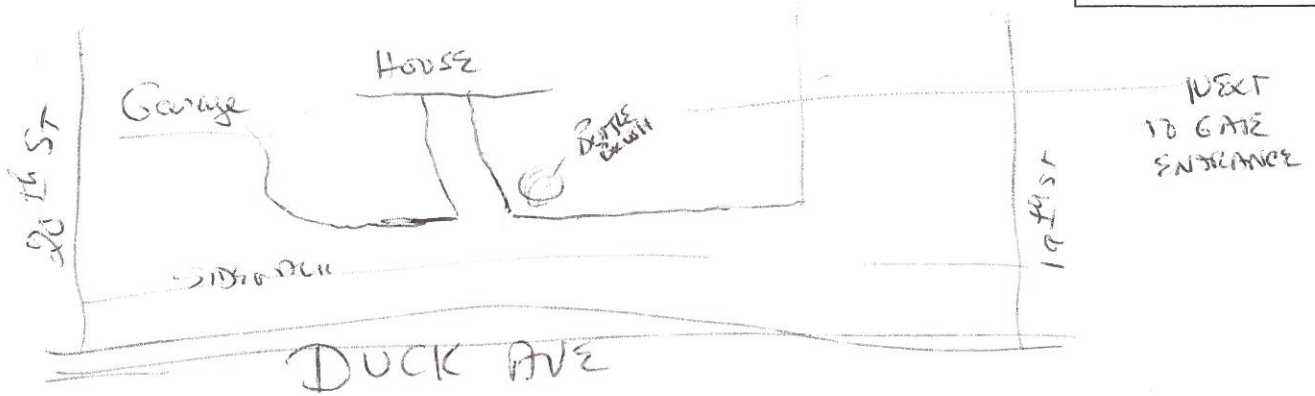
