An application was received for the removal of 1 Bottlebrush tree and 1 Mahogany tree. A site inspection was done on March 20, 2013 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Mahogany (Swietenia mahoagoni)



Diameter: 2.5"

Location: 80% (no issues right now but as the tree grows, it will impact the

foundation of the house)

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 80% (good health) Total Average Value = 86%

Value x Diameter = 2 replacement caliper (dbh) inches

Tree Species: Bottlebrush Tree (Callistemon sp.)



Diameter: total 32" Location: 80%

Species: 50% (not on protected tree list or not protected tree list)

Condition: 20% (good health) Total Average Value = 50%

Value x Diameter = 16 replacement caliper (dbh) inches





Recommendations: Recommend approval of the removal of 1 mahogany tree and 1 bottlebrush tree. To be replace with a total of 18 caliper inches.
