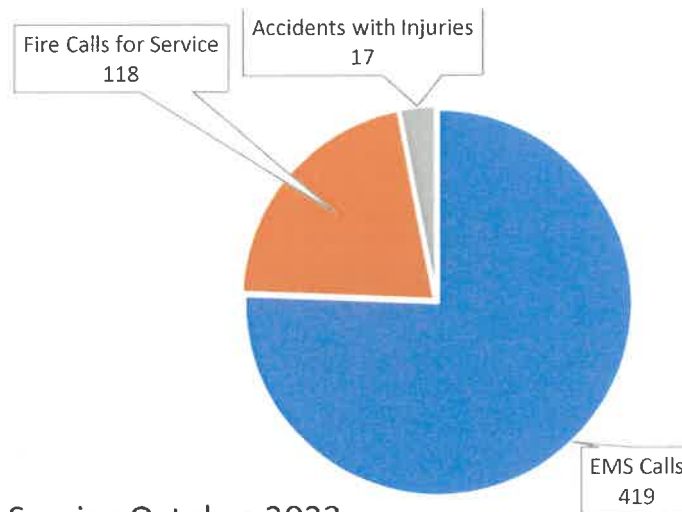

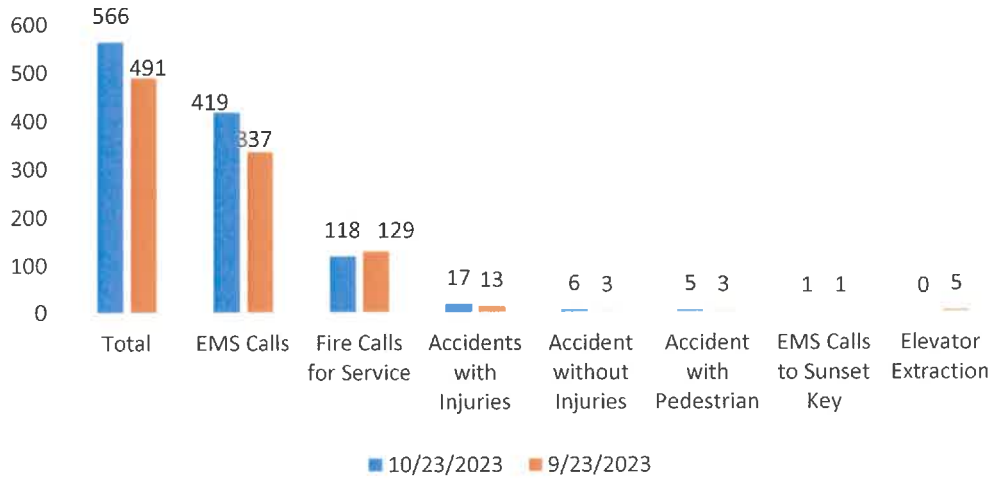
Fire Department

KWFD Calls for Service October 2023

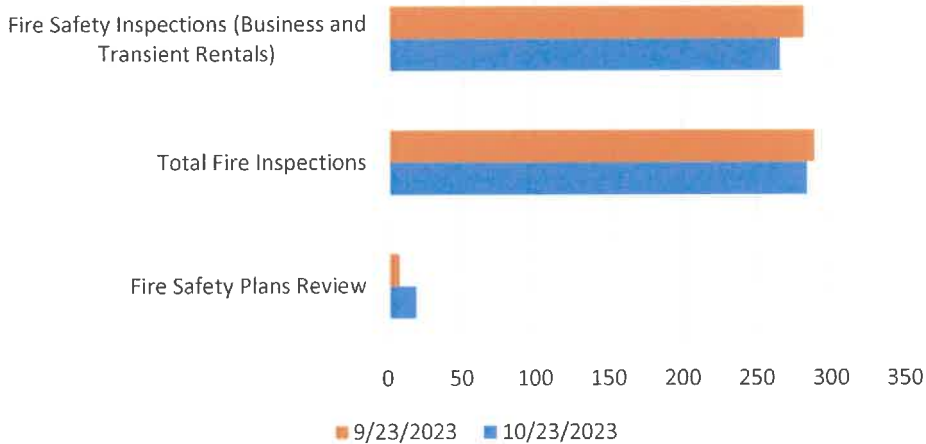
KWFD Calls October 2023 vs. September 2023

Fantasy Fest 2023 Post Incident Report

Friday October 27th, 2023

KWFD Fantasy Fest Detail Personnel & Fire Inspectors were on Fantasy Fest Detail Duty from 5PM-2AM. They checked Bars on Duval St. with no overcrowding noted at the time of their inspections. The streets with the most people were 200 & 300 Blocks of Duval St. and 400 & 500 blocks of Greene. Fire Inspectors meet with bar managers in these areas to ensure no overcrowding of bars occurs and to communicate the importance of managing crowds sizes, exits, ingress & egress, and safety by their bar staff & management.

There were several street closures noted that started at approx. 7:30 p.m. with 400 & 500 blocks of Greene St. These blocks had large crowd sizes in the 200 & 300 Blocks of Duval St. which started around 7:30 p.m.

By approx....2:00-3:00 AM the crowd sizes in these streets were starting to disperse.

Fat Tuesdays had limited occupancy for an estimated time of around 1 hour to ensure occupancy was safe at approximately 10 p.m.

Fogarty's voluntarily closed due to high occupancy and staffing issues at 11:55 p.m.

Ricks had limited occupancy for an estimated time of around 1 hour to ensure occupancy was safe at approximately 12:15 p.m.

These were voluntary limits that were set by management of the establishments in conjunction with KWFD Fire Inspectors.

KWFD detail personnel, gator units, and rescue units responded to several medical calls for help.

Between 1700 p.m. and 3 a.m. there were 5 transports and 13 calls for medical service.

Due to the high volume of crowd sizes noted last night, KWFD will be increasing detail personnel for tonight Sat. Oct. 28, 2023, Fantasy Fest Street Details & parade Details.

They checked Bars on Duval St. with no overcrowding noted at the time of their inspections. Fire Inspectors meet with bar managers in these areas to ensure no overcrowding of bars occurs and to communicate the importance of managing crowd sizes, exits, ingress & egress, and safety by their bar staff & management.

There were several street closures noted that started at approx. 6 p.m.

There were large crowds, but no establishments were closed. All inspectors went into establishments and checked capacity.

By approx....4 AM the crowd sizes in these streets were starting to disperse.

KWFD detail personnel, gator units, and rescue units responded to several medical calls for help.

KWFD had assistance from Islamorada Fire, Marathon Fire Rescue and Monroe County Fire Rescue.

Due to the high volume of crowd sizes, KWFD increased personnel for tonight Sat. Oct. 28, 2023, Fantasy Fest Street Details & parade Details until 4AM
