Description

Contract GS-35F-0195J is herein temporarily extended in accordance with FAR 52.212-4(4), Changes. The contractor shall be contractually bound to perform for the period of: January 2, 1999, original contract start date to September 30, 2011, new contract end date. During this period of performance, the contracting officer and the contractor may agree to adjust contracts upwards in accordance with the applicable negotiated economic price adjustment clause (GSAR 552.216-70) or clause I-FSS-96), negotiate to add or delete products and services in accordance with GSAR 552.243-72 MODIFICATIONS (MULTIPLE AWARD SCHEDULE). In the event the contractor fails to perform, it shall be subject to GSAR 552.238-73 CANCELLATION.

The purpose of extending this contract is to allow time for discussions between the contract specialist, contracting officer and the contractor regarding the mark-up over cost aspect of the contract. The time of these negotiations shall be by mutual consent of all parties involved. Should the contractor refuse to attend these discussions or negotiations then the contract will be allowed to expire on July 8, 2011. The period of performance of the temporary extension shall be inclusive of the subsequent five (5) year contract option period of performance that may be awarded. All other terms and conditions of the contract shall remain unchanged.
