TO CONDUCT A FUNDRAISER AT DEWITT ROBERTS FIELD (WICKERS SPORTS COMPLEX) AND PEDRO AGUILAR FIELD (CLAYTON STERLING COMPLEX) FOR THE THIRD ANNUAL MARQUES BUTLER MEMORIAL SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 28 AND SUNDAY, JANUARY 29, 2012 FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 11:00 P.M. PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 8:00 AM TO 11:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 28 AND SUNDAY, JANUARY 29, 2012; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE **HOURS** DATE AND **DURING** THE STATED ABOVE: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Rotary Club of Key West, Inc. wishes to conduct a fundraiser for the Marques Butler Memorial Softball Tournament on the date and during the hours stated above to benefit a Key West High School Senior;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida:

SECTION 1. That the Rotary Club of Key West, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct a Fundraiser on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager, and 25% of gross revenue or \$1,000.00, whichever is greater shall be donated to the Marques Butler Memorial Scholarship Fund to benefit numerous Key West High School Seniors.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Rotary Club of Key West, Inc. is hereby granted permission to allow the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 3. The Rotary Club of Key West, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 4. The Rotary Club of Key West, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrel will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
