### **DEFENDANT SHERRI HODIES' SUGGESTION OF MOOTNESS**

Defendant, SHERRI HODIES (the "Supervisor"), in her official capacity as Supervisor of Elections of Monroe County, Florida, by and through the Monroe County Attorney's Office, files this suggestion of mootness in the above-styled matter, and in support thereof states as follows:

- 1. The Supervisor is a necessary party to the action because she plays a ministerial role in verifying the signatures on the petitions within the parameters established by F.S. 100.361, the municipal recall statute.
- 2. The Supervisor made the determination that the recall petitions that are the subject of this action were submitted more than 30 days after the date of the first petition as required by F.S. 100.361(2)(f), and that, even if the petitions were timely

submitted, there was an insufficient number of petitions submitted by that 30<sup>th</sup> day to meet the threshold number of petitions required to proceed to the next step in the process. See, Exhibit 1 (written determination of Supervisor Hodies).

3. Accordingly, the instant matter is moot and subject to dismissal.

RE: Verification of Signatures on Petitions for Recall of Commissioner Lissette Carey

On July 24, 2025, I received 327 petitions and a check in the amount of \$32.70 from Key West City Clerk, Keri O'Brien for the recall of City Commissioner Lissette Carey, District IV, of Key West, Florida. District IV was comprised of 2731 registered electors as of the preceding municipal election, i.e. November 5, 2024. I had previously advised that the Recall Committee would be required to obtain a minimum of 273 signatures based on the number of registered electors in District IV pursuant to F.S. 100.361.

In accordance with F.S. 100.361 (2)(g), I must review the petitions no more than thirty (30) days after the date on which all petition forms are submitted to me by the Clerk, verify the signatures in accordance with F.S. 99.097, and determine whether the requisite number of valid signatures has been obtained. Under F.S. 99.097 (1)(a)1., I elected to review all of the petitions submitted for verification rather than a random sample as allowed.

According to F.S. 100.361(2)(f), the signed petition forms shall be filed no later than thirty (30) days after the date on which the first signature is obtained on the petition. According to the attached memo (attached as Exhibit 1) submitted to me by the City Clerk, the petition forms were initially filed with the Clerk by Aaron Strebeck, designated Chair of the Recall Committee, on July 23, 2025. A review of the petitions presented that the first date a petition was executed by a registered voter, John O'Hearn, was on June 6, 2025, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2. Thus, under the statute, the petitions would have been due to the City Clerk no later than thirty (30) days of obtaining that first signature on the petitions. The signed 327 petitions were not submitted until July 23, 2025, thus failing to meet the 30-day deadline for submission of the petitions.

Setting aside the late submission, an insufficient number of valid petitions were submitted within thirty days of the first signature. Using June 6, 2025, as the initial date, only 157 of the 327 petitions submitted were validly signed within thirty days of that date. Thus, the Recall Committee failed to meet the required 273 valid voter signatures needed to proceed to the next phase of the recall process.

It is, therefore, my determination that the recall petitions were submitted untimely, nor was there the requisite number of verified and valid signatures needed to proceed to the next step under F.S. Sec. 100.361 in the recall process.

All information on this form, including your signature, becomes a public record upon receipt by the Supervisor of Elections.

Electors of the district making charges contained in the statement of grounds for recall, as well as those signing the recall petition, shall be designated as the recall committee seeking recall of the elected official. Aaron Strebeck shall be designated as chair of the committee, and shall act for the committee.

Only registered voters of District IV, City of Key West, are eligible to sign this petition.

Lissette Carey should be recalled from the office of District IV City Commissioner for committing misfeasance, malfeasance, incompetence, and neglect of duty as a commissioner.

Lissette Carey's persistent failures in judgment and responsibility, documented by the final report of the Monroe County Grand Jury, are clear grounds for recall. Jurors reviewed evidence from the State Attorney's Office and the FBI and heard firsthand witness testimony. We agree with the jurors that Carey's actions and inactions evidence incompetence and neglect of her duties, poor decision-making, and inability to serve as Commissioner. We also agree Carey lacks the convictions needed to fulfill her official duties. The Grand Jury recommended Carey resign in the interest of the integrity and betterment of the City. Carey has not challenged the Grand Jury's findings, but has refused to resign. In her official capacity as Commissioner, Carey has distorted facts, misinformed the public, and insulted key community partners, damaging the City's ability to serve its citizens.

The public trust is further damaged with each day Carey remains in office.

We, Carey's constituents in District IV, find she wrongfully exercises the power of her office. These transgressions establish grounds for Carey to be RECALLED from office.
