NARRATIVE	

-- Lance Calland Beatty Arrest Narrative:

On March 5, 2024, at approximately 0114 hours, I, Ofc. Bernatova, while on routine patrol of Overseas Market (2700 North Roosevelt Boulevard), observed a suspicious vehicle (Toyota Tacoma bearing North Carolina license plate KHR9345 with the camping trailer attached to it).

Overseas Market has been having issues with people lodging in their vehicles at this location. The property manager requested frequent area checks and gave KWPD the official documented authorization to trespass the subjects sleeping in their vehicles at this location.

Ofc. K. Hansell and I initiated the contact with a white male sleeping in the trailer attached to the vehicle. This male was later identified by his suspended North Carolina driver's license as Lance Beatty, DOB 07/13/1979.

The trailer was set up for camping - with mattress, multiple blankets and pillows filling out the interior. Lance could be observed sleeping before woken up.

BWC activated

I knocked on the window of the trailer, woke Lance up and introduced myself. I explained to Lance that the City of Key West has an ordinance against lodging in the vehicle, and asked him to step outside to talk to me.

Lance exited the trailer, and I asked him to provide me with his identification.

Lance's eyes started darting around and he said he would like to just leave. I explained to Lance I needed to identify him to issue him the warning, and Lance walked over to the truck and retrieved his wallet from the driver's seat. Lance was about to hand me his ID, but then retrieved his hand and said he was just going to leave. I explained to Lance again he is required to identify himself and then he could be on his way. Lance said he did not want to show me his ID and placed it back in his wallet. Lance turned back towards his vehicle, upon which Ofc. K. Hansell informed him he will be placed in handcuffs.

Ofc. K. Hansell and I both reached for Lance's arms to place him in handcuffs. Lance started pulling away from us and managed to pull his arms out of our grip several times. Eventually Ofc. K. Hansell and I were able to put handcuffs on Lance and I double locked them. Lance continuously pulled away from us and trashed his body around, screaming, so I called for an additional unit.

Ofc. Ramos and Ofc. Golovanov responded to the scene and helped Ofc. K. Hansell to transport Lance towards the patrol vehicle, where he was going to be searched incident to arrest. I retrieved Lance's ID and took a step back to run his ID through Key West Dispatch on Channel 2. Lance was not following Ofc. Ramos' verbal commands, kept screaming and trashing his body. Ofc. Ramos and Ofc. Golovanov assisted Lance to the ground to be able to control him, and Ofc. K. Hansell and I held on to his legs preventing him from kicking.

Sgt. T. Peters responded to the scene to document the response to the resistance incident.

Local database revealed Lance was issued the warning about the lodging in his vehicle on 03/01/2024 by Ofc. A. Anglin.

Lance was searched and placed to the back of my patrol vehicle (Axon in-car rear camera activated).

There were two large dogs in Lance's truck, Keys SPCA responded and took possession of the dogs.

I transported Lance to Monroe County Detention Center, where he complained of the injuries he sustained while resisting. I transported Lance to Lower Keys Medical Center and after he was medically cleared, back to LKMC.

Meanwhile, K9 Ofc. M. Hansell responded to the Overseas Market, and K9 Dexter performed the exterior sniff of the vehicle. K9 Ofc. M. Hansell told me after the positive K9 alert, the search of the vehicle and the trailer revealed the total of the following:

- 1.5 Grams of green leafy substance (FTP Marijuana)
- 8.5 Grams of white rock like substance (FTP Heroin)
- 7.9 Grams of mushrooms

Victim

K9 Ofc. Hansell packaged the property and submitted it to KWPD Property/Evidence Section for evidence.

Based on all the facts and circumstances, I found probable cause Lance was trespassing on the private property by lodging in his vehicle in Overseas Market, violating FSS 810.09(2)(a); Trespassing on property other than structure or conveyance.

Based on all the facts and circumstances, I found probable cause Lance was resisting the Officers without violence by refusing to identify himself and pulling away from the Officers, violating FSS 843.02 Resisting without violence. At the time of this incident, Ofc. K. Hansell and I were on duty, executing our legal duties in full Key West Police Department uniform, clearly identifiable as a Police Officers; based on silver badge emblem that reads "Officer Key West Police FLA", above our left breasts, and "Key West Police" patches on each shoulder. Ofc. K. Hansell and I were operating the marked patrol police vehicles parked behind and next to Lance's vehicle in his clear view.

Based on all the facts and circumstances, I found probable cause Lance was in constructive possession of the controlled substance (located in his vehicle that was in his control). This controlled substance is known to K9 Ofc. Hansell by his training and experience as hallucinogenic mushrooms. By being in constructive possession of this controlled substance, Lance was violating FSS 893.13(6)(a); Possession of controlled substance without prescription.

Based on all the facts and circumstances, I found probable cause Lance was in constructive possession of less than 20 Grams of FTP Marijuana (located in his vehicle that was in his control), violating FSS 893.13(6)(b); Possession of Marijuana under 20 Grams.

Based on all the facts and circumstance, I found probable cause Lance was in constructive possession of 8.5 Grams of FTP Heroin, violating FSS 893(1)(c)(1)(a); Trafficking controlled substance.

Lance's vehicle was left parked and secured at Overseas Market Parking Lot, and the keys to his vehicle were transported and submitted to KWPD Evidence/Property Section by Ofc. K. Hansell for safekeeping.

On 3/5/2024 at approximately 0115 hours, I Officer K. Hansell was assisting Officer A. Bernatova check vehicles parked in the parking lot of 2700 N. Roosevelt Blvd (Overseas Market). There had been complaints of people sleeping in their vehicles at the plaza from the property management and patrol officers were asked to check the area.

We made contact with a gray Toyota truck with the North Carolina tag of KHR-9345 with a small towable camper attached to the truck. Officer Bernatova made contact with a male who crawled out from the passenger side of the towable camper. As Officer Bernatova was attempting to get the male's ID he stated he was not going to give her his ID and stated that he would just leave.

After being asked for his ID by Officer Bernatova multiple times, the male turned toward his driver side door while stating he was just going to leave. I stepped toward the male, took hold of his right arm, and told him to put his hands behind his back. The male immediately pulled away from me and when placed against his truck he attempted to turn around to face us as Officer Bernatova handcuffed him multiple times.

The male started yelling and continued to attempt to turn around toward us as we held him against his truck as other officers arrived on scene.

The male was taken to the ground due to him pulling away from Officers Ramos and Golovanov as they walked him toward their marked patrol unit. See Officer Ramos's report for further.

The male was identified by his North Carolina Driver License as Lance Beatty (7/13/79) after he was secured in a marked patrol vehicle.

Note that when Officer Bernatova and I made contact with Lance that we were wearing our Key West "class B" uniforms with Key West Police Department patches and badges clearly displayed on our uniforms. We also arrived in marked patrol vehicles.

Two dogs were located in the truck. SPCA was contacted and arrived on scene to take custody of the dogs.

A search incident to arrest was conducted of the truck and camper. Narcotics were located during the search. See K9 Officer M. Hansell's report for further.

A small black folding knife and the truck keys were placed into KWPD's property and evidence section for safekeeping.

On 03/03/2024 at approximately 01:18 hours, I (Officer Josue Ramos) was dispatched to 2720 N. Roosevelt Blvd (Overseas Market) to assist Officer Andrea Bernatova and Officer Katherine Hansel.

Officer Ivan Golovanov and I were conducting a plain clothes operation at the time Officer A. Bernatova called for another unit to assist.

Officer I. Golovanov and I arrived at 2720 N. Roosevelt Blvd, and I observed Officer A. Bernatova and Officer K. Hansel with a very uncooperative slender male, against Officer Hansel's patrol vehicle. The male was later identified as Lance Calland Beatty (D.O.B.-07/13/1979). Officer I. Golovanov and I attempted to escort Beatty to Officer I. Golovanov's patrol vehicle, and he began to resist our attempts to get him to the rear of the patrol vehicle. Beatty began to brace and tense his legs and arms to try to stop our forward movements. I ordered Beatty to continue to the vehicle. Once we arrived at the rear of Officer I. Golovanov's patrol vehicle, Beatty began to move his body in a bucking motion against the vehicle. Beatty attempted multiple times to pull away from Officer I. Golovanov and I by turning towards us. I ordered Beatty to comply and to not turn towards us numerous times, and I advised him if he did again, he would be taken to the ground. Beatty continued to pull away and turn towards Officer I. Golovanov and I. I performed a modified one arm take down and guided Beatty to the ground. Once on the ground Beatty continued to resist and screamed that I was killing him and hurting him. I attempted to gain compliance of Beatty and explained that once he complied all force would cease. Beatty continued to yell and flail his body on the ground, screaming and kicking. Beatty began to yell that he could not breathe. I explained to Beatty that once he calmed down, I would get him back on his feet. Beatty began to comply. Once Beatty calmed down all force ceased. I assisted in getting Beatty back onto his feet. I escorted Beatty to the rear of Officer I. Golovanov's patrol vehicle. Beatty began to yell that all he wanted to do was leave. I explained to Beatty that he could no longer leave and that he was under arrest. Beatty began to yell again from the rear of the vehicle.

Sergeant Tiffany Peters arrived to document the incident.

Sergeant Tiffany Peters captured images of Beatty's injuries. Beatty suffered scraps to his shoulders, arms and a small laceration to his left knee.

Sergeant Tiffany Peters also captured images of a small laceration I received to my left elbow.

While in the rear of Officer I. Golovanov's patrol vehicle Beatty stated that he had a knife on him.

Officer I. Golovanov and I removed Beatty from the rear of Officer I. Golovanov's patrol vehicle.

Officer I. Golovanov and I searched Beatty incident to arrest and located a pocketknife in Beatty's waistband.

On 03-05-24, I K-9 Ofc. Matthew Hansell of the Key West Police Department, responded to 2700 N. Roosevelt Blvd in reference to a request for K-9 sniff.

Prior to my arrival the vehicle owner had been arrested and taken to the Monroe County Jail. Florida Keys SPCA was in the process of taking two dogs from the truck. Once complete I was asked to conduct a K-9 sniff.

I brought K-9 Dexter out of our K-9 patrol vehicle and connected him to his six-foot lead and flat collar. K-9 Dexter was brought to the front passenger bumper area and given the command to sniff for narcotics.

I assisted with a search of the vehicle and trailer locating marijuana and a white crystal substance that I tested with an MDT kit showing positive for an Opiate-Heroine-Codeine-Morphine combination.

I collected the narcotics I found along with additional narcotics located by Ofc. K. Hansell and Ofc. Ham. I took all the narcotics to the station and placed them into an evidence locker and also completed an FDLE Form for the Opiate mixture.
