On 7/24/22 at 0124hrs, I, Officer Malak, was located at 1029 Truman Ave (Bare Assets), speaking to Alan Houlihan about a previous case.

A male (Robert Kroot) and a female (Cynthia Brooks) exited the business stumbling saying how much of a good time they were having. Houlihan, working at the business, had seen the couple drinking alcoholic beverages for some time and given their current condition, offered to get them a taxi back to their hotel. Kroot stated they did not need a taxi and that they were going to "Try" and ride their rental scooter home. Brooks followed up by saying she wasn't going to drive, but Kroot could "probably get them home".

While both Kroot and Brooks were speaking and walking by me, I observed them to be noticeably impaired. Kroot had bloodshot glassy eyes, slurred speech, and a strong smell of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. I had the same observations of Brooks, but she was also stumbling while attempting to walk straight.

I advised Kroot and Brooks they should take the Taxi offer, just to make sure everyone got home safe. Kroot stated "Go fuck yourself" while continuing to walk towards the scooter parked in a handicapped space. Brooks continued to call me an "asshole" and stated they were going to take the scooter, "they will be fine". I advised Kroot, if he gets on the scooter and even attempts to drive away, I will have to begin a DUI investigation and things wouldn't turn out well for them this evening. Kroot proceeded to tell me to "fuck off" and walk away.

Approximately 45 seconds later, Kroot returned to 1029 Truman and continued to call me an "asshole" and telling me to "go fuck myself, he was taking the scooter". I approached Kroot and explained the seriousness of my statement and again asked him to go home while things were still cordial. Kroot grabbed both handlebars of the scooter, with his keys in hand, and start to move the scooter off its kickstand. I grabbed the scooter, placing it back on the kickstand, and again told Kroot to just go home, none of this is worth the trouble it will cause.

At this time, Brooks came walking back up to the scene and stated I was still being an asshole. Brooks telling Kroot to give her the phone so she could record me being an asshole. Kroot began to push Brooks down the sidewalk and grabbed her by the head. As the two continued down the sidewalk, approximately 30 feet, I observed Kroot grab Brooks by the neck with his open hand. Kroot pushed Brooks against the wall and yelled at her.

I requested additional units to the scene and approached the now arguing couple. Kroot walked right up to me talking about his illegally parked scooter. I advised him to step back and to get out of my face. Kroot did not listen to my commands, so with my one right hand, I pushed him back to regain my reactionary gap. I continued to speak with Kroot and Brooks until Officer Litton arrived on location. Once Officer Litton was present, I advised Kroot he was under arrest for Domestic Battery. I grabbed Kroot's Right arm and placed it behind his back, with Officer Litton grabbing his left. Kroot began to tense up and actively attempt to pull away while the arrest action was in progress. I instructed Kroot to stop resisting and comply with the commands given, Kroot refused. Officer Howell arrived on scene and helped us gain control of Kroot. When the attempt to handcuff Kroot failed, I verbally announced that I was directing Kroot to the ground. I grabbed Kroot by both shoulders and put him on his stomach. Kroot continued to resist by placing his hands under his body. Kroot was given multiple orders to give us his hands and to stop resisting, he continued to disobey. I delivered a knee strike to Kroot's left side in efforts to gain control of his hands. Once receiving the knee strike, Kroot gave both hands to officers, where he was handcuffed.

After being handcuffed, Kroot continued to struggle, I placed my right thumb on the back of his left ear. This is a position of pain compliance, although there was little to no pressure applied. Kroot kept raising his head into my

During the arrest process of Kroot, Brooks was attempting to interfere by running up to us. Officer Slaunwhite and Officer Hernandez attempted to keep her back, but due to her behavior, she was also placed into handcuffs.

It should be noted, during this incident, a crowd formed to watch. Vehicles were stopping on Truman Ave as well to see what was happening.

Brooks was assisted into Officer Slaunwhite's vehicle, where she was informed of her arrest for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting without violence.

Kroot and Brooks both stated they are married and live together in the same household. I confirmed the same living situation by reading their FL Driver's Licenses.

Sgt. Rodriguez contacted KWFD for a medical evaluation of Kroot's eye. KWFD cleared Kroot, with Kroot refusing medical care. Once the medical portion was completed, I advised Kroot he was under arrest and was being transported to Monroe County Jail for processing.

Once I secured Kroot in my patrol vehicle, I spoke to Houlihan, and he completed a written statement in regard to what he observed.

Once completing my actions on scene, I transported Kroot to Monroe County Jail. Kroot was refused by The Jail Nurse, and I transported him to Lower Keys Medical Center for further medical evaluation. Kroot was cleared and discharged my LKMC and I brought him back to Monroe County Jail, where he began the intake process.

My BWC and in car Fleet system was active for this incident.

Robert Kroot actually and intentionally struck Cynthia Brooks about the torso and grabbed her by the neck. Brooks did not consent to the contact and I, an active-duty Police Officer witnessed the offense. Therefore, Kroot is being charged with FSS 784.03-1A1, Battery. Due to their relationship and living status, this charge will be classified as a Domestic Violence incident.

Robert Kroot was informed of his legal arrest for Domestic Battery. Kroot knowingly and willfully resisted the arrest process by actively tensing up and pulling away from officers. Kroot took an aggressive stance and was direct to the ground before any further harm could come out of the arrest. All officers on scene were wearing Class B uniforms issued by the Key West Police Department. Therefore, Robert Kroot is being charged with FSS 843.01 Resisting with Violence.

When I arrived, Officer T. Malak was being confronted by a suspect by the name of Robert Kroot, who Officer T. Malak was trying to convince to walk away. As I walked up, Officer T. Malak informed me Kroot was going to jail for domestic violence. I grabbed Kroot's left arm and placed it behind his back. Kroot resisted once me and Officer T. Malak each grabbed one of his arms. Kroot attempted to pull away from me and Officer T. Malak, despite Officer T. Malak's commands to place his hands behind his back and to stop resisting. Officer T. Malak told Kroot he would be taken to the ground if he continued to resist. Officer T. Malak gave several more warnings to stop resisting before he told Kroot he was taking him to the ground.

I released my grip on Kroot as Officer T. Malak took him to the ground. I then reengaged with Kroot's right arm, continuously giving him commands to place his hands behind his back. Kroot continued to resist as he laid on his stomach, defying commands to place his hands behind his back. Kroot eventually put his hands behind his back for me to place him in handcuffs. I then retrieved Kroot's wallet from his right leg pocket to run his ID on Key West Dispatch channel 2. Sergeant A. Rodriguez arrived on scene. I advised Sergeant A. Rodriguez of my actions during this incident.

This concludes my involvement in this case.

On Sunday July 24, 2022, at about 0144 am hours, I, (Ofc. L. Hernandez), arrived at 1029 Truman Avenue (Bare assets), to provide back up assistance for Ofc. Timothy Malak who requested backup on a domestic incident in progress.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Malak, Ofc. W. Howell and Ofc. A. Litton were trying to detain the male half of this incident, Robert Joseph Kroot (DOB 08/18/1975). I saw Kroot trying to pull away from Ofc. Malak and trying to defeat Ofc. Malak's attempts of placing him in handcuffs. Ofc. Malak, Ofc. Litton and Ofc. Howell repeatedly gave Kroot loud and cleared commands to stop resisting. Kroot had to eventually be brought down to the ground in a controlled manner.

Kroots wife, later identified as Cynthia Sue Brooks (DOB 07/21/1972), was using her cellphone to record the incident and getting close to the officers that were detaining Kroot at about 3-4 feet distance. I put my left hand out towards Brooks and told Brooks to stay back. Brooks backed away but then returned and began to close in on us again and was screaming and instigating to draw a crowd of bystanders. Ofc. D. Slaunwhite began to try to detain Brooks for disorderly conduct and obstruction of justice and she resisted Ofc. Slaunwhite attempts to place her in custody by tensing up and refusing to turn around. Brooks also knocked down Ofc. Slaunwhite's Body Worn Camera (BWC) from his chest during the struggle. I then assisted Ofc. Slaunwhite placing Brooks in handcuffs. Ofc. Slaunwhite checked them for tightness, and double locked them. Ofc. Slaunwhite and I walked Brooks to a patrol vehicle where she was placed in the rear and in car Coban was activated.

While on the ground Kroot was still resisting by trying to keep his arms under him. I assisted in detaining Kroot by holding his legs down to prevent him from using them to kick officers. We were eventually able to place Kroot in handcuffs.

My BWC (3452) was activated during this incident. This concludes my involvement in this incident.

On Sunday, 07/24/2022 at approximately 0142 hours, I (Ofc. Howell) responded to 1029 Truman Avenue to provide assistance with an unknown white male subject being aggressive during a possible battery investigation by Ofc. Malak.

Ofc. Malak witnessed an unknown white male subject grab an unknown white female subject by her neck and push her into a wall.

I arrived on scene as Ofc. Malak and Ofc. Litton were placing the unknown white male subject in handcuffs. The unknown white male subject was eventually identified as Robert J. Kroot (DOB: 08/18/1975, Arrestee.) As Ofc. Malak, Ofc. Litton, and I attempted to place Kroot in handcuffs, he suddenly and swiftly pulled away and lunging forward away from us. Kroot was instructed to stop pulling away and to stop resisting by all officers involved. Kroot continued to yell obscenities toward Ofc. Malak and continuously refused to comply with our lawful, legal orders. Due to Kroot's actions, continuous aggression, and level of resistance rising Ofc. Malak placed Kroot on the ground in a controlled manner. Ofc. Litton and I assisted Ofc. Malak while he finally placed Kroot in handcuffs.

Ofc. Malak and Ofc. Litton searched Kroot subsequent to arrest.

Ofc. Malak transported Kroot to Monroe County Detention Center.

Due to Kroot's actions, he received a small laceration that was approximately one inch in length between his right eyebrow and right eye.

Key West Fire/Rescue refused to treat Kroot on scene, due to aggressive actions.

My BWC was activated for Ofc. Malak's use of force as well as Kroot's arrest and subsequent search. I uploaded the video to Evidence.com.
