

On Monday, 04/29/24, at approximately 1728hrs, I (Ofc. Clark), while on routine patrol of the intersection of Ann St and Caroline St, observed a wanted subject (probable cause for arrest for an earlier theft case KWPD 24-2375, Ofc. F. Betz). This would become a Fentanyl arrest.

#### \*\*\*BWC activated\*\*\*

The subject, was known to me from previous narcotics investigations as, John Jacob Weaver 05/26/93. John was riding a red bike on the sidewalk. I exited my marked patrol vehicle, in full uniform with badge displayed. I issued verbal commands for Weaver to take a seat. I ordered him several times to take a seat and he seemed hesitant to comply. I noticed in Weavers right hand he was concealing a plastic baggie with a clenched fist. A tactic known to me for quick release of narcotics, upon law enforcement contact to hide its presence.

Weaver then sat on a wall and began to move the fist behind him with the concealed baggie. I told him to keep his hand where I can see it as he began reaching behind himself again. I went to grab the hand, and saw him toss a plastic baggie behind the wall, in efforts to conceal, or destroy it.

I kept control of Weavers right wrist as he actively, and physically pulled away from my grasp. I ordered Weaver to the ground as he pulled away from me. I attempted a straight arm take down, escorting Weaver to his knees as he pulled away and ignored lawful verbal commands. I ordered Weaver to place his hands behind his back so I may place him under arrest several times. He refused my commands, still actively pulling from my grasp. I controlled Weavers head with my left hand, as he attempted to stand and pushed him forward so he would not regain his balance. Weaver then complied and I placed him under arrest.

Ofc. F. Betz arrived on scene. I told Ofc. Betz where Weaver attempted to conceal the suspected contraband behind the wall. Ofc. Betz located it. It was a clear plastic baggie containing a white powdery substance (later FTP Fentanyl 4.2grams, submitted to FDLE).

Weaver had involuntary spasms and due to my knowledge of his narcotics history and my suspicions of Fentanyl use, I requested EMS respond. Weaver suffered no visible injuries during this incident.

Search incident to arrest, Ofc. Betz located a blue plastic (straw, made from a pen case), with a burned residue FTP Fentanyl, in Weavers jeans pocket (later submitted to evidence).

EMS transported Weaver to LKMC for treatment (Ofc. J. Ramos-Martinez rode with them).

Once Weaver was cleared from the hospital, I read him his Miranda Warnings. Weaver did not wish to speak to me, but offered to buy narcotics for the Police Department.

I transported Weaver to jail with my in-car camera activated.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to charge Weaver with the following:

One count, Trafficking Fentanyl, 4 grams or more, FSS 893.135(1)(c)(4)(a)- for the FTP 4.2 grams FTP Fentanyl, he had in his possession during lawful arrest in his right hand.

One count, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, FSS 893.147 (1), for the FTP Fentanyl smoking pipe, located in Weavers pocket, search incident to arrest.

One count, Tampering with evidence, FSS 918.13, for attempting to conceal the 4.2grams FTP Fentanyl, and remove the contraband, with the purpose to impair its verity or availability during lawful arrest.

One count, Resisting without violence, FSS 843.02, for willfully and intentionally, disobeying my lawful commands, and physically resisting my efforts to lawfully place him under arrest. I was in full KWPD uniform with badge displayed and am known to Weaver.

On 04/29/2024 at approximately 17:28 hours, I (Officer Josue Ramos) was dispatched to the corner of Caroline St and Ann St to assist Officer Thomas Clark who was dealing with a Felony Warrant suspect.

I arrived and met with Officer T. Clark who had one white male in hand restraints. The man was identified as John Weaver (D.O.B-05/26/1993).

While I escorted Weaver to the rear of my Patrol Vehicle, he stated he wanted to be evaluated by EMS.

I placed Weaver in the rear of my patrol vehicle. As I placed Weaver in my Patrol Vehicle, I observed him to be very fidgety and appeared to be under the influence of some type of narcotic. While in the rear of my Patrol Vehicle Weaver stated he did not feel well, complained he was hot and having a medical emergency.

Officer T. Clark called for Key West Fire Rescue to respond.

KWFR responded and paramedics placed Weaver in the rear of the ambulance. I advised dispatch I would be riding with KWFR to Lower Keys Medical.

Weaver was placed under arrest by Officer T. Clark for having an outstanding Felony Warrant. Weaver received additional chargers because prior to my arrival Weaver had attempted to discard a white powdery substance into a nearby yard. Weaver was additionally charged for trafficking FTP Cocaine laced with Fentanyl, resisting arrest without violence, and Narcotic possession.

I waited for Weaver to get medically cleared at Lower Keys Medical Center.

Weaver was medically discharged from Lower Keys Medical Center, Officer T. Clark arrived, and we escorted Weaver to the Monro County Detention Center without incident.

Since I left my Patrol Vehicle on-scene at the corner of Caroline St and Ann St, Officer Eric Roberts arrived at the MCSO detention center to assist with my transport back to my patrol vehicle.

When I arrived back at my Patrol Vehicle, I observed that I had Weavers iPhone which was taken and secured in my vehicle when he was taken under arrest by Officer T. Clark.

I observed the phone ringing and noticed it had multiple missed calls and unanswered text messages. I observed missed

calls from "Marcia". Without tampering with the device or manipulating it, I observed unanswered text messages from "Nando", "Jess2", and "MichaelN". I did not initially observe anything until I read a text message from the lock screen, that came from "Jess2". The text message stated, "Hey love I got some "white" the same as the other day".

Weaver has a lengthy history of Narcotic use, Narcotic sales, and frequents know drug areas/houses. On approximately 04/26/2024 Weaver was found overdosing at 508 Simonton St and transported to Lower Key Medical Center by KWFR for treatment.

Since I observed unanswered text messages relating to the possible purchase/sale of Narcotics without tampering with Weaver's device while I had it in my possession, I seized Weaver's iPhone. I later entered it as Evidence to the Key West Police Department property division, where Detective Jorge Lopez will possibly be seeking a search warrant for the phones content.

My Axon BWC and Axon Fleet In-Car were activated for the incident and later uploaded it to Evidence.com.

I had no further involvement with the incident.
