A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE FLORIDA KEYS SOCIETY FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS, INC. TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL ROYAL CORONATION FOR FANTASY FEST AT THE KEY WEST TRUMAN WATERFRONT COFFEE BUTLER AMPHITHEATER ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2025, FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN AN ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Florida Keys Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, Inc. wishes to conduct the Royal Coronation for Fantasy Fest at the Truman Waterfront Coffee Butler Amphitheater between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Friday, October 17, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida as follows:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene

products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor, therefore, commits to refrain from the use or distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City.

SECTION 3. The Florida Keys Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct the Royal Coronation Ball on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, The Florida Keys Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That The Florida Keys Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age. Proof of compliance with Supplement F, paragraph 3 of the application is required at least ten (10) days in advance.

SECTION 6. The Florida Keys Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash container will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. The Florida Keys Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, Inc. will be responsible for the rental fee of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. In addition, The Florida Keys Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, Inc. will be required to pay the Police, Fire and Community Services.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
