A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR A WEDDING CEREMONY AND RECEPTION AT THE HEMINGWAY HOUSE AT 907 WHITEHEAD STREET DURING THE HOURS OF 5:45 P.M. TO 11:00 P.M. ON SUNDAY, MARCH 8, 2020; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance; and

SECTION 1. That the Wedding party are hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the place and time as herein described.
