A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(3)c OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE DISPOSAL OF ONE 2001 GILLIG PHANTOM LOW FLOOR BUS (#806); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2011, a fire began in the engine compartment of bus #806 during regular operations, resulting in extensive damage to the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the conditions surrounding the fire, and the resulting damage to the bus was investigated by the City, the bus manufacturer, and the City's insurance provider, PGIT, resulting in the bus being declared a total loss; and

WHEREAS, due to the damage, and normal depreciation, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has released its title lien on the vehicle to the City of Key West in order to facilitate disposal of the vehicle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That disposal of one 2001 Gillig Phantom Low Floor Bus (#806) is hereby approved.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
