An application was received for the removal of one (1) Royal Palm Tree.

A site inspection was done on January 27, 2012 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Royal Palm (*Roystonea regia*)

Diameter: 17.6" dbh – 25' grey wood

Location: 60% - (in fence area)

Species: 100% - (on city protected tree list)

Condition: 80% - (palm tree in good health)

Total Average Value = 80%

Value x Diameter = replacement caliper (dbh) inches =  $.80 \times 17.6" = 14" \text{ replacement}$

Recommendations: Staff recommends **denial** of permit. This large palm is very valuable and does not appear to be causing excessive damage to private walkway. With scheduled maintenance and trimming, roots can be controlled and fronds can be removed.
