

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING KEY WEST ART AND HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INC. TO CONDUCT A "BACK IN TIME FUNDRAISER" AT 281 FRONT STREET ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 22, 2026, FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M (SET UP AT 9:00 A.M.); PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE BARRICADED AREA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Key West Art and Historical Society, Inc. wishes to conduct a "Back in Time Fundraiser" at the Custom House and Clinton Place during the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on January 22, 2026 (set-up beginning at 9:00 a.m.).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA.

SECTION 1. That In Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor

therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City.

SECTION 3. That Key West Art and Historical Society, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That proceeds will be used Custom House capital projects.

SECTION 5. That Key West Art and Historical Society, Inc. is hereby granted permission for the use of Clinton Place.

SECTION 6. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Key West Art and Historical Society, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 7. That Key West Art and Historical Society, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 8. That Key West Art and Historical Society, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1)

recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 9. That Key West Art and Historical Society, Inc. acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 10. That this resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
