B.S.S.P will commence work as soon as an agreement is accomplished.

PROPOSAL SYNOPSIS

B.S.S.P. intends to provide Key West facilities with the following security services as specified in the request for proposal (R.F.P.)

- Ensures via patrol guards facility building grounds are safe for tenants, staff, visitors, and Key West property.
- Through a rigorous system of visitor screenings and passes insures identification of unauthorized and/or suspicious persons anywhere on Key West premises.
- Restrains/detains trespassers, the belligerent, and/or emotional disturbed persons

(E.D.P.), on Key West grounds or facilities and as situationally appropriate correspondence with medical and/or law enforcement officials will be determined on a case by case situational analysis.

- Rapid response protocol to resolve detected fire safety hazardous or other unusual circumstances or conditions.
- Consistent enforcement of all city rules and regulations (supported by signage)
 with regards to designated hours of visitation, smoking, and parking enforcement.
- Maintenance of the visitor passes register, daily logs, incident reports, and daily security reports detailing any unusual occurrences. Quarterly incident review conferences with Key West staff are proposed.
- Patrol guard escorts upon request for Tenants, staff, or visitors to any Key West location.
- Assist any Key West employee upon request.
- Coordinates emergency response with designated Key West staff (Manager on duty, etc.), as well as any other designated staff.
- Support Key West operations such as notices, regulations, and routine tasks

The following services will be provided as per specifications:

- 1 Provide internal security for your facilities; check all access doors, monitoring door, locks, and windows.
- 2 Patrol building grounds, property, safety of personnel, and visitors.
- 3 Check for any unauthorized or suspicious persons on premises. Detaining when or wherever needed.

DELIVERABLE SERVICE PLAN

The services to be provided will be rendered in the manner described as follows:

CENTRAL COMMAND STATION

To provide comprehensive security, Blue Shield will monitor and secure the entire Key West y facilities. Blue Shield's proposes a command station to be staffed with a senior supervisors and guards on a 8-hours basis, 365 days a year.

- The control command station will monitor and direct guard patrols upon the external grounds and within the Key West structure in case of an emergency.
- The central command station will call and coordinate external contacts with police, fire,

and all other external emergency responders in consultation with Key West staff, especially the manager on duty will also communicate with B.S.S.P. or via 2-way radio system.

- The senior supervisor will receive requests for additional services such as but not limited to transportation, relief is for breaks. The senior supervisor will determine the appropriate guard, to execute such requests on a case-by-case basis.
- The senior supervisor will initiate a rapid response protocol to subdue, restrain, or detain an unauthorized individual upon the premises. The protocol will include involvement of local law enforcement representatives.

GUARD STATION

At each of the city locations shall be a guard station. Each patrol vehicle security guard will have a metal detector, phone, and two-way radio. Each guard will be provided with a 2-way radio to contact the central command station as needed. The patrol guard will be at a strategic entry to Key West.

One guard will always be on patrol. The patrol will include inspection of doors, locks, and windows. The patrol guard will generate reports of tampered locks and/or any other related irregularities while on patrol.

The patrol guards will detect any threat to Key West properties, employees, and visitors. The patrol guards at each of the Key West locations will also respond to reports of suspicious and or unauthorized persons on the premises.

The patrol guards will inform the senior supervisor at central command as well as the respective manager on duty of any fire injury, safety hazard, unusual conditions, malfunctioning of heating, cooling, plumbing, or electrical systems.

The patrol guard will also monitor the entrance and halls of each floor.

The patrol guard will be the first responder to an emergency call or disturbance within the premise or outer locations.

The patrol guard on patrol of Key West premises will utilize a daily sign-in journal and record unusual circumstances. A daily security officer's log will be completed daily. Incident reports will be completed on an as needed basis and be reviewed on a quarterly basis to determine the efficiency of response and to target trends.

EXTERIOR GUARD PATROL

The exterior patrol guards will be responsible for Key West parking rules enforcement and upon request or as necessary will escort Key West staff, and visitors to the parking lot(s).

The exterior guards will patrol and ensure that the Key West exterior property is free of

any exterior defect or condition that might result in hazard and or injury to tenants, staff, and visitors. No loitering will be always enforced. Quality of life issues will be address and always monitored

 The exterior guards will use automobiles to expedite inspection and coverage of Key West grounds, and complete appropriate incident reports and daily log entries.

STAFF SHIFT COMPOSITION

The staff shift composition will be as follows:

Per shift on each Key West base on 8 Hrs basis

- 1 Supervisor per sector
- 2-External grounds patrol guards in vehicles

GUARD PRE-ASSIGNMENT TRAINING

Pre-assignment – 16 hours of training that includes real-life scenarios, role playing, question and answer sessions and a challenging examination. Each guard will be licensed as a security guard and a fire guard. Training topics will include:

- a. Arrest concepts and limitations
- Use of force guidelines
- c. Legal Powers and Limitations
- d. Ethics and Conduct
- e. Functions of a Security Guard
- f. Emergency Situations
- Report writing and documentation
- h. U.S. Constitution and Civil Rights Review
- Public Relations
- i. First Aid training and certification
- k. CPR training and certification

On-Site – Training must be conducted when the guard is first assigned to the Key West and should be at least eight hours in duration. Training should focus on the Key West area and boundaries, location of critical equipment and facilities, site policy, and procedures, post orders, communications procedures, and emergency response procedures.

Blue Shield Security will provide the guards with uniforms consisting of gray slacks, blue blazer (which may include the Blue Shield Security's insignia or logo), a dress shirt, a tie, and as the weather dictates, a coat, and a hat (which may include the Blue Shield Security's insignia or logo) (the "Uniforms"). The uniforms must be always kept neat and clean in appearance and should be replaced by the Blue Shield Security as soon as they show signs of wear and tear.

If a guard leaves his or her assigned Post, Blue Shield Security must immediately cover that post with a relief guard not already assigned elsewhere.

GUARD RESTRICTIONS

Blue Shield Security must inform the guards as to all rules and contract restrictions imposed by Key West Facility on their behavior (the "Restrictions"). Key West will require the guards to strictly observe the restrictions while at any Key West facilities. The Restrictions:

- a. No smoking.
- b. No alcohol.
- c. No use of illegal drugs.
- d. No use of private communication devices for personal usage, limitation, cellular telephones, beepers, 2-way radios or walkie-talkies.
- e. No use of radios, tape players, CD players, MP3 devices or other portable or Walkman-type music systems.
- No use of televisions or DVD players.
- g. No audio or video recorders.
- No personal reading.
- No playing games.

No person convicted of a felony, or of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, or who has been refused fidelity bonding, may be assigned to perform services. In addition to any provision of federal, state, or local law or regulations regarding the hiring of security guards with which Blue Shield Security may be required to comply. Blue Shield Security shall be responsible for conducting a drug test and criminal background check, which each guard must pass. All records pertinent to such investigation shall be made available to Key West management, upon request.

Except as authorized in writing in advance, each guard must be:

- a. Licensed as a security guard possess the necessary work authorization documents required to legally work in the United States and have reached the age of twentyone (21).
- b. Literate to the extent of reading and understanding printed regulations, written orders, and instructions, training instructions, and being able to compose reports that convey complete information.
- c. Able to acquire a good working knowledge of all the duty requirements of a guard within the terms of the service agreement.

STAFF QUALIFICATIONS

Supervisors will have between 10 years' experience at the managerial level. Experience in the field of law enforcement and will possess all security certification necessarily.

Guards will have between 1- and 5-years' experience preferred in law enforcement experience and will possess security certifications necessarily.

THE CITY OF KEY WEST E-VERIFY AFFIDAVIT

Furthermore, the undersigned contractor agrees that it will continue to use E-Verify throughout the contract period, and should it employ or contract with any subcontractor(s) in connection with the performance of services pursuant to this Agreement with The City of Key West, contractor will secure from such subcontractor(s) similar verification of compliance with Florida Statute § 448.095, by requiring the subcontractor(s) to provide an affidavit attesting that the subcontractor does not employ, or subcontract with, an unauthorized alien.
