## Introduction

Staff recommends that City Commission award the Bid Proposal from Charley Toppino & Sons Inc for the construction of the Dennis St Phase II Stormwater Improvements Project, in the amount of \$988,500, and authorize the City Manager to execute necessary budget adjustments, and/or transfers and contract documents upon consent of the City Attorney.

#### **Background**

The Dennis St. Phase II Stormwater Improvements project proposes to:

- Replace catch basins and collection piping on Venetia from the intersection of Dennis St to Duncombe St. After which, this section of roadway will be milled and repaved.
- Re-profile and re-pave Dennis St between Blanche St and Venetia St.
- Install low flow "jockey" pump and associated controls in the pump station to address smaller event storms and nuisance intrusion flows.

This project was designed by Stantec Consulting Services Inc under the City's General Engineering Services contract as approved by Resolution 24-011. A competitive Request for Proposals was advertised in the Keys Citizen and Demandstar on March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025, and two (2) responsive Bid Proposals were opened on April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025 from Reynolds Construction LLC, and Charley Toppino and Sons Inc., with Charley Toppino and Sons submitting the apparent low bid in the amount of \$988,500.

#### **Financial**

Funds for Dennis St Phase II Stormwater Improvements project have been budgeted in Stormwater Construction/Construction in Progress Account Number 402-3802-538-6500, Project Number ST38022401

## Recommendation

Staff recommend that City Commission approve the Construction Proposal from Charley Toppino and Sons Inc in the amount of \$988,500 and authorize the City Manager to execute necessary budget adjustments and/or transfers and execute construction contract documents upon consent of the City Attorney.
