Dear Commissioner Weekley,

As impacted neighbors, we ask that the City of Key West consider taking steps to alleviate the ongoing dangerous high speed vehicular traffic on Southard Street from White Street to Simonton Street. Southard Street is the only residential east-west street that has no stop signs or traffic lights to control traffic and protect pedestrians and bicyclists. We understand that the City is undertaking a Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Transportation Plan project which may take some time to approve and implement.

As an interim solution, we propose adding three 4-way stop sign intersections to materially calm traffic without adversely affecting traffic demands:

Replace the blinking light at Frances Street with 4-way stop signs.

Reinstate the 4-way stop signs at Margaret and Southard Streets that existed for decades while the school was operating.

Place 4-way stop signs at William Street.

Dear Commissioner Weekley,

As impacted neighbors, we ask that the City of Key West consider taking steps to alleviate the ongoing dangerous high speed vehicular traffic on Southard Street from White Street to Simonton Street. This residential neighborhood is the only north-south street that has no stop signs to control traffic and protect pedestrians and bicyclists.

We recommend the following location of stop signs which will calm traffic in our residential neighborhood:

Replace the blinking light at Frances Street with 4-way stop signs.

Reinstate the 4-way stop signs at Margaret and Southard Streets that existed for decades while the school was operating.

Place 4-way stop signs at William Street.

These three 4-way stop signs will materially calm traffic without affecting traffic demands.
